Sir,

In producing herewith arrested accused namely Gopal Barman (55) s/o Lt. Kalipada Barman of Debhog, P.S. Bhabanipur, Dist. Purba Medinipur (Hotel cum-Shop keeper of illegal liquor den) I, ASI Rajendra Chakraborty of Bhabanipur P.S. do here by lodged complaint against Gopal Barman to the effect that on 28.06.17 at about 21.15 hrs. SI Kajal Dolui of Bhabanipur P.S. received secret information that illegal sale of I.D. liquor is going on at Debhog, near JVL factory at the hotel cum shop of Gopal Barman. This has a reference to Bhabanipur PS GDE No. 1209 dt. 28.06.17.

I have been directed to work out the information and accordingly myself along with C/887 Dubai Hembram and C/1397 Manas Mudi left P.S. for Debhog, near JVL factory at 21:05 hrs to work out the information.

On 28.06.17 at about 21:15 hrs myself accompanied by force reached at Debhog, near JVL factory identified the liquor den and held raid at the hotel cum shop of Gopal Barman. Seeing police some persons who were seating and consuming I.D. liquor started to flee away. It revealed that the accused Gopal Barman is selling unauthorized liquor to consumer violating the law of the land relating to such stock and sale governed in the Bengal Excise Act.

I in presence of witness (i) Bharati Barman w/o Gopal of Debhog, (ii) Khokan Debnath s/o Phonibhusan Debnath of Bhabanipur, both of P.S. Bhabanipur, Dist. Purba Medinipur searched the shop in between 21:20 hrs to 21:35 hrs and found 10 liters I.D. liquor in one plastic jerkin valued rupees sixty per liter. (Total valued Rs 60X 10 = Rs. 600/-), which I seized duly signed by the witnesses and seller. Sample was taken on the spot duly sealed and labeled by me.

In spite of my several request the said shopkeeper Gopal Barman could not be able to produce the license or any valid document for selling those liquor and confessed that he actually stocked ID liquor at his shop and selling illegally. On enquiry it came to learnt that Gopal Barman running this illegal business since long causing loss of Govt. revenue. Hence Gopal Barman (55) s/o Lt. Kalipada Barman of Debhog, P.S. Bhabanipur, Dist. Purba Medinipur was taken into custody at 21:45 hrs after issuing memo of arrest duly signed by him as he violated the provision of sec 18 (I) of Bengal Excise Act and he committed an offence u/s 46A (C) of Bengal Excise Act, 1909.

Under the above circumstances I request you to start a specific case against the said Gopal Barman (proprietor of the Hotel cum shop) and arrange for its investigation.
