Sir,

In producing herewith arrested accused namely i) Ashis Bhunia (35) S/o. Badal Bhunia of Barabari PS. Bhabanipur PS. Dist- Purba Medinipur (Shop keeper of illegal liquor den) I, SI.Kajal Dolui of Bhabanipur P.S. Dist. Purba Medinipur do hereby lodge complaint against Ashis Bhunia (35) to the effect that during Special raid duty on 17.04.17 duty officer received telephonic information from reliable source that illegal sale of I.D. liquor and others is going on at Barabari under Bhabanipur PS. at the shop of Ashis Bhunia (35). I was directed to work out for the information.

In course of special raid duty myself along with force ASI. Rajendra Chakraborty of Bhabanipur PS. left for Barabari under Bhabanipur PS. to work out for the information.

On 17.04.17 at about 20:45 hrs. myself accompanied by force reached at Barabari under Bhabanipur PS. search for local witnesses and found two volunteers namely i) Harihar Samanta S/o. Madan Samanta of Barabari PS. Bhabanipur Dist. Purba Medinipur ii) Rabindra nath Jana S/o. Biran of CVF at Bhabanipur PS. Dist. Purba Medinipur to attend during the time of raid. Identified the liquor den and held raid at the shop of Ashis Bhunia (35). Seeing police personals some persons who were seating and consuming I.D. liquor started to flee away. It was revealed that the accused Ashis Bhunia (35) is selling unauthorized liquor to consumer violating the law of the land relating to such stock and sale governed in the Bengal Excise Act.

I, in presence of witnesses i) Harihar Samanta S/o. Madan Samanta of Barabari PS. Bhabanipur Dist. Purba Medinipur ii) Rabindra nath Jana S/o. Biran of CVF at Bhabanipur PS. Dist. Purba Medinipur iii) ASI. Rajendra Chakraborty of Bhabanipur PS searched the shop in between 21:25 hrs to 21:40 hrs and found i) 10 Ltrs ID Liquors (Total valued Rs-60x10=600/-) and ii) 03 pieces pet bottles Super power -600 ml. country spirit (RS-55 X 3=165/-) iii) 03 Piece officers choices (RS-100x 3=300/-) which I seized from the possession of Ashis Bhunia (35) S/o. Badal Bhunia of Barabari PS. Bhabanipur PS. Dist- Purba Medinipur duly signed by the witnesses and seller. Sample was taken on the spot duly sealed and labeled by me.

In spite of my several request the said shopkeeper Ashis Bhunia (35) could not be able to produce the license or any valid document for selling those liquors and confessed that he actually stocked ID liquor at his shop and selling illegally. On enquiry it came to learnt that Ashis Bhunia (35) running this illegal business since long causing loss of Govt. revenue. Hence Ashis Bhunia (35) S/o. Badal Bhunia of Barabari PS. Bhabanipur PS. Dist- Purba Medinipur was taken into custody at 21:45 hrs. after issuing memo of arrest duly signed by her as he violated the provision of sec 18 (I) of Bengal Excise Act and she committed an offence u/s 46A (C) of Bengal Excise Act, 1909.

Under the above circumstances I request you to start a specific case against the said Ashis Bhunia (35) S/o. Badal Bhunia of Barabari PS. Bhabanipur PS. Dist- Purba Medinipur (Shop keeper) and arrange for its investigation.
