In producing herewith the arrested accused Bharat Pariya(31) S/O- Lt. Kanai Pariya of Mohammadpur, PS- Bhagwanpur, Dist- Purba Medinipur alongwith Seizure List and the following seized articles as per Seizure List:

- (1) One white colour big plastic bag on which 'PARAS PELLET FEEDS' is written in blue colour containing total four brown colour plastic packets weighing total 24.700 Kg[Marked as Exhibit-A]. said to be containing 'Ganja'. From it 100 gms sample [Marked as S1] was taken out .
- (2) One white colour big plastic bag on which 'Camfeed' is written in black colour. It contains three brown plastic packets said to be containing 'Ganja' [Marked as Exhibit-B] and it weighs 20.600 Kg. From it 100 gms sample is taken out and marked as Exhibit-S2.
- (3) One jute bag containing four brown colour plastic packets said to be containing 'Ganja' and it weighs 16.100 Kg[Marked as Exhibit-C]. From it 100 gms contents is taken out and Marked as Exhibit-S3.
- (4) One white colour plastic big bag in which two brown colour plastic packets said to be containing 'Ganja' total weighs 17.500 Kg[Marked as Exhibit-D]. From it 100 gms sample is taken out and Marked as Exhibit-S4.

I SI Manoj Kumar Jha, O/C Bhagwanpur PS do hereby lodge a written complaint against the said Bharat Pariya(31) S/O- Lt. Kanai Pariya of Mohammadpur, PS- Bhagwanpur, Dist- Purba Medinipur to the effect that today on 21-01-17 at about 18:05 hrs I received a secret source information that one Bharat Pariya of Mohammadpur has illegally kept 'Ganja' in his house for the purpose of selling . I examined the source, on examining the source information appeared to be reliable and credible and immediately informed the CI, Egra, my immediate superior who directed me in writing to work out the source information. I diarized the information vide Bhagwanpur PS GDE No.835 dated 21-01-2017. Accordingly, I equipped myself with necessary articles like carbon paper, brown paper, scale, pad, sealing wax, metal specimen scale, candle, match box, packing plastic box, electronic weighing scale and kit box to work out the source information. Accordingly, myself along with C/1150 Bimal Mandi, C/622 Durjodhan Manna left the PS with PS vehicle no – WB26C-7295 driven by P/D 810 Dilip Kumar Pal vide CC No. 237/17 dated 21-01-17 and myself directed the on duty patrolling officer ASI Joygopal Das to come at Mohammadpur village with his team . At 19:05 hrs myself alongwith the team arrived at Mohammadpur under Bhagwanpur PS and keeping the vehicles at a distance we entered into Mohammadpur village and my source identified me the house of said Bharat Pariya from distance and he left therefrom. In producing herewith the arrested accused Bharat Pariya(31) S/O- Lt. Kanai Pariya of Mohammadpur, PS- Bhagwanpur, Dist- Purba Medinipur alongwith Seizure List and the following seized articles as per Seizure List:

- (1) One white colour big plastic bag on which 'PARAS PELLET FEEDS' is written in blue colour containing total four brown colour plastic packets weighing total 24.700 Kg[Marked as Exhibit-A], said to be containing 'Ganja'. From it 100 gms sample [Marked as S1] was taken out .

- (3) One jute bag containg four brown colour plastic packets said to be containing 'Ganja' and it weighs 16.100 Kg[Marked as Exhibit-C]. From it 100 gms contents is taken out and Marked as Exhibit-S3.
- (4) One white colour plastic big bag in which two brown colour plastic packets said to be containing 'Ganja' total weighs 17.500 Kg[Marked as Exhibit-D]. From it 100 gms sample is taken out and Marked as Exhibit-S4.

I SI Manoj Kumar Jha, O/C Bhagwanpur PS do hereby lodge a written complaint against the said Bharat Pariya(31) S/O- Lt. Kanai Pariya of Mohammadpur, PS- Bhagwanpur, Dist- Purba Medinipur to the effect that today on 21-01-17 at about 18:05 hrs I received a secret source information that one Bharat Pariya of Mohammadpur has illegally kept 'Ganja' in his house for the purpose of selling . I examined the source, on examining the source information appeared to be reliable and credible and immediately informed the CI, Egra, my immediate superior who directed me in writing to work out the source information. I diarized the information vide Bhagwanpur PS GDE No.835 dated 21-01-2017. Accordingly, I equipped myself with necessary articles like carbon paper, brown paper, scale, pad, sealing wax, metal specimen scale, candle, match box, packing plastic box, electronic weighing scale and kit box to work out the source information. Bharat Pariya and cordoned the house so that none can leave that house. The house owner seeing police came out and started to flee but we detained him and on being asked he disclosed his identity as Bharat Pariya(31) S/O- Lt. Kanai Pariya of Mohammadpur, PS- Bhagwanpur, Dist- Purba Medinipur .Then we called neighbouring people namely Subhash Pariya S/O-Ranjan and Ashok Kumar Pariya S/O- Judhithir and Niranjana Singh S/O- Lt. Kshudiram all of Mohammadpur, PS- Bhagwanpur . I informed them giving our identity ,our intention for making search the house of Bharat Pariya as credible information received that the said house owner Bharat Pariya illegally stored 'Ganja' in his house . I briefed my accompanying officer / Force about the nature and purpose of the Police operation. I disclosed my identity as well as of the police personnel and public witnesses to the above referred suspect and stated him that I had information that he has kept "Ganja" in his house. I further told him being an Officer-in-Charge of Bhagwanpur Police Station, I have been empowered to search him and his house if he desired it could be done in presence of an Executive Magistrate or Gazetted officer and I issued a written Notice(Option-I). He is willing for search in presence of a Gazetted officer. I received a written reply from him. Since it was reasonable for me to believe that the suspect has kept Ganja,in his house, I informed the development to CI, Egra ,Sri Bishnupada Bera over phone and requested him to come to the spot himself. CI Egra instructed me to detain the suspected person on the spot and replied that he would be reaching very soon. At 19:55 hrs ,CI Egra Sri Bishnupada Bera arrived at the P.O and disclosed his identity as Gazetted officer before the suspected person as well as before the witnesses and informed the detained person about the reason of his arrival and asked the detained suspected person whether he requires the presence of a Gazetted Officer for conducting his search . In this respect ,CI Egra Sri Bishnupada Bera again issued a written notice (Option-II) to the detained person and he consented to for the search operation and also by writing. He was also offered to conduct search of all the Police personnel before proceeding to search him and his house and he replied positive. Hence all the police personnel raiding team including me , the witnesses as well as CI Egra were searched by the suspect in presence of the witnesses but nothing suspicious could be found out on any of the Police personnel. As per order and in presence of CI, Egra Sri Bishnupada Bera, I myself alongwith C/1150 Bimal Mandi and C/622 Durjodhan Manna proceeded for search in presence of witnesses and the CI, Egra and during search I found a healthy quantity of Ganja (as appeared from appearance and smell) contained in a brown polythene sheet packs inside three big white colour polythene bags and one Jute bag. I weighed the said "Ganja" with the help of electronic weighing scale and found it to be 78.900 kgs(net weight). I then drew a sample of 100 grams of Ganja (net weight) as sample from the each four bags. I then again weighed the main stock which stood as 78. 500 Kg (net

weight). I put the 78 Kg 500 Gms of Ganja in its original transparent polythene sheet and the sample of 400 grams(four sample packets containing 100 gms each) of Ganja in a white transparent poly packed. Preparing proper seizure list attested by witnesses , detainee and under my signature . I seized the above articles I labelled and sealed the main stock marked as Exhibit -A,B,C and D. I also labelled and sealed the four packets as the test sample quantity of 100 gms of ganja in each of four transparent poly packs covered by off white colour plastic boxes, marked as Exhibit S1,S2,S3 and S4. The CI, Egra also certified the seizure list and label by putting his signature. The accused also signed on the seizure lists, and also obtained his signature on the the seizure lists as an acknowledgement to the copy of seizure lists duly provided to him. On demand the detained person could not produce any valid document in support of keeping and possessing such huge amount of "Ganja". So I arrested him at 22: 15 hrs after communicating him the ground of his arrest and issued memo of arrest. I asked him about the source of procurement, names of persons involved in this racket and purpose and destination of delivering of seized 'Ganja' but he kept mum at this moment.

The whole process of seizure continued from 20.35 hrs to 21.45 hrs on 21.01.17. From the above facts and circumstances, it is evident that the arrested accused said Bharat Pariya is illegally possessing the huge quantity of 'Ganja' at his house and as such he committed offence u/s 20 (b)(ii)(C) of NDPS Act 1985 and as such I do this suomoto complaint and registered Bhagwanpur PS Case No.23/17 dtd. 21-01-2017 u/s 20 (b)(ii)(C) of NDPS Act 1985 against the Bharat Pariya(31) S/O- Lt. Kanai Pariya of Mohammadpur, PS- Bhagwanpur, Dist- Purba Medinipur and endorsed to SI Biswajit Mondal for its investigation.
