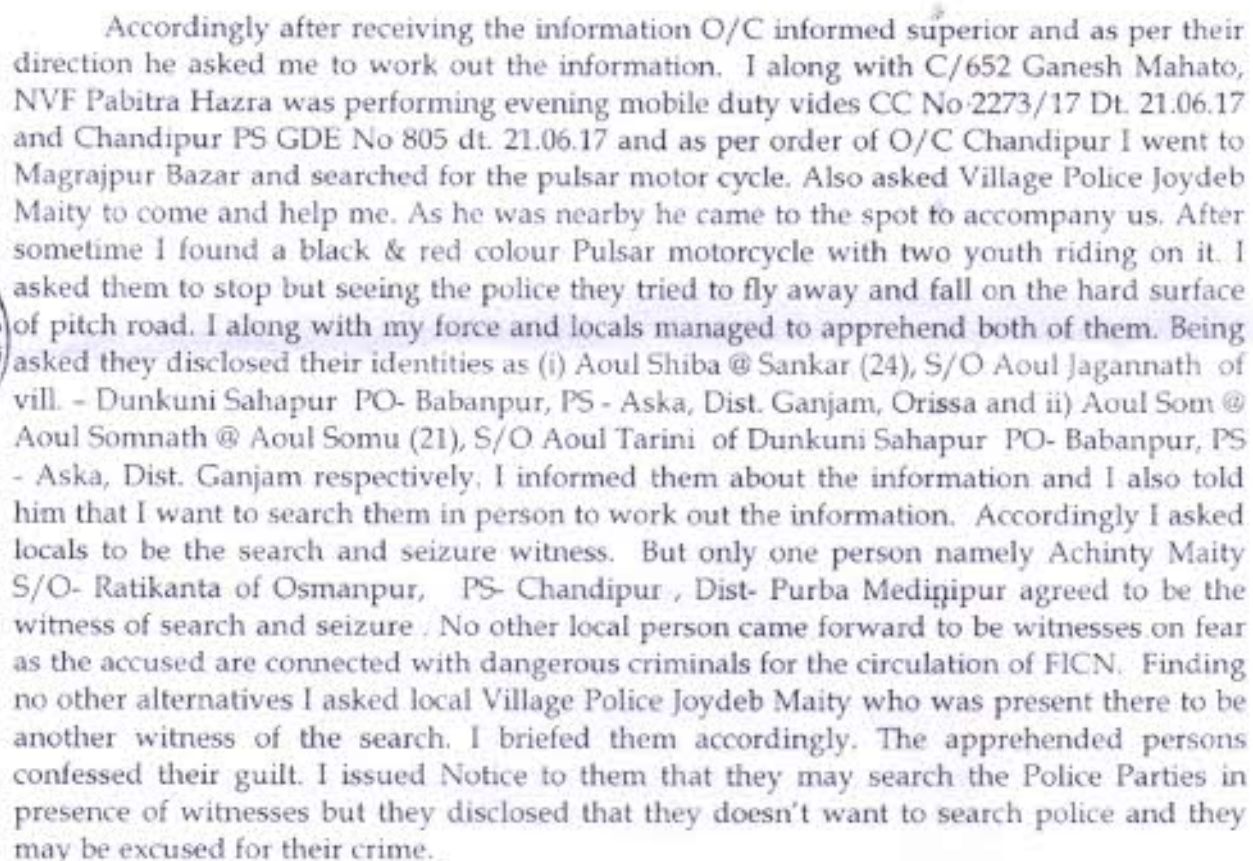

duly packed sealed and label and with proper seizure list, I SI Arun Kr. Pati of Chandipur P.S, Dist. Purba Medinipur do here by lodge this written complainant to the effect that today on 21.06.17 at 16.05 hrs O/C Chandipur PS received an source information from reliable source that two persons are using the forged bank notes of denomination of Rs. 100/- each and the notes are as genuine that can't be deferred from original one in ordinary open eyes. They are also circulating the same forged bank notes in different places. Presently they are roaming at Chandipur area with one black & red colour Pulsar Motor Cycle without number plate to hand over some fake Indian Currency notes to different agents for circulation in different place. At present they are at Magrajpur Bazar. O/C diarised the information in Chandipur P.S General Diary Book vide Chandipur P.S GDE No. 812 dated 21.06.17.



Accordingly observing formalities, I searched the above noted persons in presence of those two witnesses as well as police witnesses and from the possession of Aoul Shiba @ Sankar (24), S/O Aoul Jagannath of vill. - Dunkuni Sahapur PO-Babanpur, PS - Aska, Dist. Ganjam, Orissa found total thirty four (34) nos of forged Indian Currency notes of denomination Rs. 100/- each said to be forged bearing the following serial No :- 6EQ 670375, 6EQ 670378, 6EQ 670375, 6EQ 670375, 6EQ 670381, 6EQ 670378, 6EQ 670378, 6EQ 670375, 6EQ 670375, 6EQ 670381, 6EQ 670378, 6EQ 670375, 6EQ 670381, 6EQ 670375, 6EQ 670381, 6EQ 670378, 6EQ 670375, 6EQ 670381, 6EQ 670378, 6EQ 670375, 6EQ 670381, 6EQ 670378, 6EQ 670375, 6EQ 670381, 6EQ 670378, 6EQ 670375, 6EQ 670381, 6EQ 670378, 6EQ 670381, 6EQ 670375, 6EQ 670381, 6EQ 670378, 6EQ 670375, 6EQ 670378, 6EQ 670381 and also found four (04) nos of original Indian Currency notes of denomination Rs 100/- each bearing serial No 3EC 313995, 4HW 307863, 3EC 313998, 3EC 313997, and one black red colour Bajaj Pulsar Motor Cycle without number plate having engine No DJYCHA91045, Chasis No-MD2A12DY7HCA20041. Above notes was inside the pocket of the trouser of Aoul Shiba @ Sankar. Accordingly I seized them under proper seizure list duly signed by the witnesses and the thumb impression of the person from whom these were seized i.e. of Aoul Shiba @ Sankar. I also took thumb impression of the accused over the seized forged currency notes. I also I packed the seized thirty four (34) nos of forged Indian Currency notes in a brown envelope and sealed and labled in presence of witnesses and marked as Exhibit "A". Above seized notes were inside the pocket of the trouser of Aoul Shiba @ Sankar

I also searched Aoul Som @ Aoul Somnath @ Aoul Somu (21), S/O Aoul Tarini of Dunkuni Sahapur PO- Babanpur, PS - Aska, Dist. Ganjam, Orissa and found forty three (43) No's of forged Indian Currency notes of denomination Rs 100/- each said to be forged bearing the serial Nos- 6EQ 670375, 6EQ 670381, 6EQ 670378, 6EQ 670375, 6EQ 670381, 6EQ 670378, 6EQ 670375, 6EQ 670381, 6EQ 670378, 6EQ 670375, 6EQ 670381, 6EQ 670378, 6EQ 670375, 6EQ 670375, 6EQ 670381, 6EQ

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On interrogation they disclosed that they came from Odisha with several bundles of forged Indian Currency Notes all in denomination of Rs. 100/- each for circulation in area as the notes are not checked properly during exchange and for this reason the circulation is easy. They also confessed that they had already circulated many such noted in Chandipur , Bajkul, Digha , Nandakumar Tamluk etc area. There are many such persons are doing such act in different area to circulate the forged Indian currency notes of denomination of Rs. 100/- as these notes are not checked properly during exchange. On interrogation they failed to give any satisfactory answer in support of possession of such forged currency and doesn't disclosed about the origin of such forged notes.

Thereafter I arrested them for offence punishable U/S 489B/489C/120B IPC after communicating them the ground of arrest and issued memo of arrest. Left for PS with the seized articles and arrested two accused persons.

Therefore on returned to the PS I submit this complaint against the above two arrested accused (i) Aoul Shiba @ Sankar (24), S/O Aoul Jagannath of vill. - Dunkuni Sahapur PO- Babanpur, PS - Aska, Dist. Ganjam, Orissa and ii) Aoul Som @ Aoul Somnath @ Aoul Somu (21), S/O Aoul Tarini of Dunkuni Sahapur PO- Babanpur, PS - Aska, Dist. Ganjam, Orissa and others for their involvement in offence punishable U/S 489B/489C/120B IPC and request you to start a case for the investigation.
