Sir,

In producing here with arrested accused Ganesh Bhakta (45 yrs) S/O Basudeb of Vill- Barahchandi, P.S.- Chandipur, Dist- Purba Medinipur along with following seized articles I SI Badal Nayak of Chandipur PS beg to state that On 13.01.17 at 20.55 hrs while myself along with force were performing evening duty at Chandipur PS area received information from source that one ID liquor manufacturing unit is running in the house of above noted accused person at Vill- Barahchandi, P.S.- Chandipur. After receiving the information I informed to O/C Chandipur PS about the matter. As per direction of O/C Chandipur PS I along with and C/ 209 Md. Idrish, C/203 Bholanath Das and LC/1705 Monalisha Das Adhikary deputed in evening mobile duty vide PS C.C. No. 158/17 dated 13.01.17 and 6 nos of CV had been to the P.O. at Barahachandi and on arrival on the spot at 21.45 hrs I encircled the house of above accused with my force and CV, I found that there is a temporary ID liquor manufacturing unit in the house of above accused person and found smell of "Cholai" is coming out. Accordingly I called some people locally to assist police for their presence during search the ID liquor manufacturing unit. On request one Sukumar Bhakta S/O- Lt Binoy of Vill- Barahchandi, and Mahadeb Das S/O- Santosh of Gargram, P.S.- Chandipur, Dist- Purba Medinipur agreed to be witnesses to conduct search and seizure of the house. Then I with force and L/C and the above two witnesses entered into the house and found that illegal ID liquor, manufacturing articles etc are lying in his house and also found accused Ganesh Bhakta into the house. I asked to Ganesh Bhakta for producing license or any documents for running ID liquor manufacturing unit but he failed to produce the same. On local enquiry it could be learnt that accused Ganesh Bhakta is the kingpin of illegal manufacturing of ID liquor along with other localities.

Accordingly I searched the house in presence of witnesses and seized (1) 30 (thirty) Ltrs of raw ID Liquor (Cholai) in a rubber bladder (2) Fermented Wash 100 Ltrs (approx) in four tins, (3) Molasses 20 kg. in a one tins (4) 02(Two) Plastic Funnel, (5) 01(One) Plastic pipe length around 10 ft. (ten feet) and (6) one aluminum made "handi" from the said house possession of accused person after preparing proper seizure list signed by witnesses and accused person. I also took sample of following seized articles for examination by expert. Sample (A) 01(one) glass bottle containing 600 ml ID liquor collected from seized articles serial No. 1, Sample (B) 01(one) glass bottle containing 600 gm Molasses collected from seized articles serial No. 3 and I also labled the sample in presence of witnesses duly signed by them and the accused Ganesh Bhakta. I destroyed the seized fermented wash 100 Ltrs and rest molasses at the spot after seizure, as it was not possible to carry such huge quantity of fermented wash and also it is likely to be injurious of health for is foul smelling. Also keeping of such fermented wash and molasses for a long will destroy the containers and contaminate the other articles of Malkhana. So finding no other alternative I destroyed the fermented wash and the rest molasses. On interrogation the above accused confessed that the used to produce 'Cholai' at his house and during preparation of the ID liquor he used to mix chemicals for early fermentation to reduce the production time and he know that the overuse of such chemical likely to cause disability and death to human beings. On further interrogation he disclosed that the cost of the seized 30 (thirty) ltrs of raw ID Liquor (Cholai) is approx Rs. 2100/- (Two thousands and one hundred only). So I arrested the accused Ganesh Bhakta (45 yrs) S/O Basudeb of Vill- Barahchandi, P.S.- Chandipur, Dist- Purba Medinipur for running illegal ID liquor manufacturing unit and mixing of chemicals with the ID liquor which may cause lass of life of the consumer and possession of such produced ID liquor which is punishable U/S 46A (a) (b) (c)/46AA of Bengal Excise Act 1909. During arrest he was informed about the ground of his arrest and his family members were informed.

I therefore request before you to start a specific case against the arrested accused person as per law and oblige.
