I, S.I. Biplab Halder, Officer-in-Charge of Chandipur PS, Dist- Purba Medinipur after return to PS producing herewith two arrested accused persons namely (1) Sankar Patra (22) S/O- Bhutnath of Chak Shibrampur ,PS- Bhagwanpur , Dist- Purba Medinipur and (2) Ramesh Das (23) S/O- Krushna Ch. Das at Ramchandrapur , PS- Digapahandi, Dist- Ganjam , Odisha and producing the following seized articles,

- 1) Approximate four kg and four hundred gm. (4400 gm). of loose ganja wrapped with polythin and brown cello tape labeled & sealed and marked as Exhibit "A" (which was kept in the black color laptop carry side bag on which "Genx" is engraved .)
- 2) One black color laptop carry side bag on which "Genx" is engraved.
- 3) Approximate five Kg and eight hundred and eighteen gm (5818 grms) of loose ganja wrapped with polythin and brown cello tape labeled & sealed and marked as Exhibit "B" ( which was kept in the ghee color carry side bag on which logo "TOREX" is written by rubber paste)
- 4) One ghee color carry side bag on which logo "TOREX" is written by rubber paste,

do hereby lodge a written complaint as Suo-Motu against above noted arrested accused persons to the effect that on today i.e 14.05.17 at 14.05 hrs I received a secret source information from a reliable source that two youth both aged about 22/23 yrs, one with dark complexion wearing blue T-shirt with color and grey colour trouser and another with fair complexion with high power spectator in his eye, built- thin wearing navy blue T shirt and brown colour trouser, would be carrying bags with some amount of ganja in their possession which would be transported to Bhagwanpur through Baroj in between 16.30-17.00 hrs for selling the same to someone of Bhagwanpur, in exchange of money. I examined the source properly. On examining the source, information appeared to be reliable & credible. Immediately I informed my superiors (C.I Nandakumar, S.D.P.O Tamluk, Addl S.P (Hq), and the SP Purba Medinipur) about the details of the source information over telephone and in writing to my immediate superior C.I Nandakumar and he was pleased to direct me to work out the source information and also directed me that he will contact B.D.O Chandipur for conducting the search in case the need arises. I diarized the information vide Chandipur PS G.D.E No- 506 dated- 14.05.17 at 14.25 hrs. Accordingly myself along with S.I Tapas Kr Das, C/581 Pintu Das, C/229 Gouranga Dutta, VP Sahadeb Jana vide CC No 1727/17 and two available Civic volunteer left PS accompanied by my source by PS hired Vehicle No- WB-31-7119 driven by public driver Pintu Mondal S/O- Rajani Kanta Mondal of Mograjpur ,PS- Chandipur, Purba Medinipur and equipped with necessary articles like weighing balance, weight ranging from 10 gms to five kgs, paper , carbon paper, brown paper, pen, scale, stamp ,pad, sealing wax, metal specimen scale , candle , matchbox etc to work out the source information. This has reference to Chandipur PS G.D.E No 508 dtd 14.05.17 at 15.15 hrs. We arrived near Baroj at 15.35 hrs and keeping the vehicle at a distance in a by-lane, we walked down towards Baroj Bazar. On way I requested local disinterested respectable pedestrians namely (1) Sankar Jana S/O- Nikhil of Bijoy Maity Chak, PS- Chandipur, Purba Medinipur, (2) Narayan Ch. Maity S/O- Motilal of Uttar Shibrampur PS- Bhagwanpur, Dist- Purba Medinipur, and (3) Anil Maity S/O- Jatindranath Maity of Bijoy Maity chak , PS- Chandipur , Purba Medinipur who happened

to the place for their personal business ( work) to accompany police Party in holding raid Program . All of them voluntarily agreed to my proposal to accompany Police party as witness. However, I disclosed my identity as S.I Biplab Halder, Officer-in-Charge of Chandipur PS, and then I stated before them the nature of raid. I also briefed all of my accompanying officers /force about the nature of raid and purpose of the police operation. We ambushed, and waited beside Baroj Bazar along with the above mention witnesses.

At about 16.45 hrs. two youth persons matching with the description as stated by the source were seen to get down from a trekker which was coming from Chandipur side, both carrying side bags on their shoulder. They were searching someone aimlessly. As indicated and identified by the source, the police party came out of ambushing and surrounded the persons promptly. On being asked, they disclosed their identity as (1) Sankar Patra (22) S/O-Bhutnath of Chak Shibrampur ,PS- Bhagwanpur , Dist- Purba Medinipur, West Bengal and (2) Ramesh Das (23) S/O- Krushna Ch. Das at Ramchandrapur , PS- Digapahandi, Dist- Ganjam , Odisha and started begging mercy for their crime. I informed the development to superiors and also Shri Tirtha Bhattacharjya C.I Nandakumar ,(who was present at Chandipur PS at that time) over phone and requested him to come to the spot himself or with an executive Magistrate as I have every reason to believe that the intercepted persons were carrying N.D.P.S and also the apprehended persons confessed it on being asked. C.I Nandakumar instructed me to detain the suspected person on the spot' and replied that he would be reaching very soon as the B.D.O, Chandipur (Executive Magistrate) could not be contacted as he was not available at his office due to Sunday at such odd hours of time. Shri Tirtha Bhattacharjya C.I Nandakumar arrived at the spot at 17.25 hrs and disclosed his identity as Gazetted officer, of Govt. of West Bengal before the suspected person as well as before the witnesses and informed the detained person about the reason of his arrival and asked the suspected/detained person whether he required the presence of an Executive Magistrate for conducting search of his person an if so, necessary arrangement would be done. In this respect, under instruction of C.I Nandakumar, I issued written notice to (1) Sankar Patra (22) S/O-Bhutnath of Chak Shibrampur ,PS- Bhagwanpur , Dist- Purba Medinipur and (2) Ramesh Das (23) S/O- Krushna Ch. Das at Ramchandrapur , PS- Digapahandi, Dist- Ganjam , Odisha . They were also offered to conduct search of all the police personnel before proceeding to search of the suspected person & they denied searching police personal. However, all the police personal including C.I Nandakumar were searched by the witnesses in presence of the apprehended persons and nothing suspicious could be found out on any of the police personal. Hence a nil seizure list was prepared. Shri Tirtha Bhattacharjya C.I Nandakumar asked the apprehended persons whether they are willing to be searched by a Gazetted officer present there on the spot or wants to be searched in presence of Executive Magistrate. The apprehend persons expressed their willingness to be searched by a Gazetted officer i.e Shri Tirtha Bhattacharjya C.I Nandakumar .The suspects were served with a notice in writing on which he signed and stated that he had got no objection if the search is conducted in presence of C.I Tamluk being a Gazetted officer.

As per order and in presence of Shri Tirtha Bhattacharjya C.I Nandakumar, I searched the apprehended persons one by one observing all legal formalities. During search

of Sankar Patra (22) S/O-Bhutnath of Chak Shibrampur ,PS- Bhagwanpur , Dist- Purba Medinipur, found one big packet wrapped with polythin and brown cello tape containing loose ganja (as appeared from appearance and smell) kept in the black color laptop carry side bag on which "Genx" is written . Under instruction of C.I Nandakumar, I measured the said Ganja by electronic weighing machine at "Bindu Basini Sar Bhandar" at Baroj Bazar of Anil Maity S/O-Jatindranath Maity of Bijoy Maity chak , PS- Chandipur , Purba medinipur. which was found approximate four kg and four hundred grm. (4400 grm). Then I searched another apprehended person Ramesh Das (23) S/O- Krushna Ch. Das at Ramchandrapur , PS- Digapahandi, Dist- Ganjam , Odisha and one packet wrapped with polythin and brown cello tape containing loose ganja (as appeared from appearance and smell) kept in the ghee color carry side bag on which logo "TOREX" is written. I also measured the said Ganja by electronic weighing machine at same "Bindu Basini Sar Bhandar" as noted above and found approximate five Kg and eight hundred and eighteen grm (5818 grms). I packed, labeled and sealed the above two packets of loose ganja as noted above and marked as Exhibit "A" and Exhibit "B" respectively. I seized the same under proper seizure list duly signed by the witnesses and also packed by brown papers and label on above exhibits and lable were also signed by the witnesses and the above apprehended persons. I also take written declaration regarding measurement of the seized ganja from Anil Maity S/O-Jatindranath Maity of Bijoy Maity Chak, PS- Chandipur , Purba Medinipur, prop of "Bindu Basini Sar Bhandar" at Baroj Bazar. On demand the above apprehended person could not able to produce any valid document in support of carrying and possession of such huge quantity of Ganja and they confessed that they are carrying the same illegally. I asked them about the source of procurement; names of persons involved in this purpose and destination of delivering of such seized Ganja and they informed that they are carrying the Ganja from Ganjam District of Odisha for sale in Bhagwanpur area. So I arrested them after communicating them the ground of arrest under proper memo of arrest.

The whole process of seizure started from 17.45 hrs and concluded at 18.45 hrs on 14.05.17. On 14.05.17 at 19.05 hrs myself along with above arrested accused persons and seized articles and all the police personals left P.O for P.S. I reached P.S at 19.35 hrs, assumed the Charge of PS and started a case u/s 20 (b) (ii) (B) NDPS Act 1985 against the arrested accused persons namely (1) Sankar Patra (22) S/O-Bhutnath of Chak Shibrampur ,PS- Bhagwanpur , Dist- Purba Medinipur and (2) Ramesh Das (23) S/O- Krushna Ch. Das at Ramchandrapur , PS- Digapahandi, Dist- Ganjam , Odisha as Suo Motu vide Chandipur PS Case No- 97/17 dtd- 14.05.17 U/S- 20 (b) (ii) (B) NDPS Act 1985 and S.I Badal Nayak will please investigate this case.
