In producing here with arrested alleged person namely Sambhu Giri (37) S/o.- Haradhan of Dholmari, Ps. - Contai, Dist.- Purba Medinipur with 12 bottles sealed Country spirit @ Rs.-65/- each, Total value Rs. - 780/-

I ASI Nirmal Banerjee, presently posted at Contai Ps. do hereby lodged a complaint as Suo-moto to the effect that on 10.03.17 in course of my evening patrolling duty with C/1515 Amit Ranjan Bar & C/542 Nupur Maity under Ps. area, at about 19:15 hrs. I received a telephonic information from reliable sources that one person namely Sambhu Giri S/o.- Haradhan Giri of Dholmari, Ps.- Contai Dist.- Purba Medinipur was selling liquors near Dholmari under Contai Ps. since few years.

Accordingly, I inform to I/C Contai Ps. and as per his direction myself along with force reached at Dholmari under Contai Ps. at about 20:15 hrs. and found that said alleged selling Liquors from his house among to some public illegally. On being searched, 12 bottles Country Spirit in one nylon bag were recovered from his possession. On being asked, he could not produce any valid documents in favour of those liquors. There after, I seized the same under proper seizure list duly signed by the witnesses. I arrested him and during interrogation, it reveals that the alleged Sambhu Giri S/o.- Haradhan was selling liquors from there since few years.

Under the above fact and circumstances, I therefore pray that a case may kindly be started U/S- 46(A) B.E. Act. against said Sambhu Giri S/o.- Haradhan of Dholmari, Ps.- Contai Dist.- Purba Medinipur.
