Dear Sir,

I do hereby lodge a written complaint empowered by the Electricity Act 2003 read with Amendment Act 2007 against Sri Satish Chandra Nayak, S/O- Lt Srikanta Nayak of Vill: & P.O- Paniparui, P.S-Egra, Dist-Purba Medinipur has committed theft of Electricity u/s 135 of the Electricity Act 2003 read with Amendment Act 2007 as stated here under.

On 06.06.2017 at about 12:30 PM, I, Sri Manas Maity, AE(U), S&LP, Contai Division, along with Sri Sudipta Rong, AE & SM Chorepalia CCC, Sri Ratan Bhunia, SAE (E) Egra CCC, Sri Joydeep Mitra, OE, Chorepalia CCC and others had been to the Vill: Paniparui, P.S-Egra for routine inspection purpose. At first we went to the Domestic premises Sri Satish Chandra Nayak, S/O- Lt Srikanta Nayak of Vill: & P.O- Paniparui, P.S-Egra, Dist-Purba Medinipur and during inspection it was found that Sri Satish Chandra Nayak, S/O- Lt Srikanta Nayak of Vill: Paniparui, P.S-Egra, Dist-Purba Medinipur consuming electricity unauthorisedly by way of tampering the service cable for bypassing the energy meter unauthorisedly in respect of Consumer Id No: 200312185, Meter No: L4367744, in view of less recording of unit or energy in to the energy meter, causing loss of revenue to WBSEDCL in the tune of load 1.170 KVA.

As theft of electricity was detected during the inspection the service cable was cut from pole and some portion of 2 core round shape black Colour PVC Coated tampered 6 sq mm aluminium service cable of length of 1 (one) meter approx along with bypass arrangement made by another 2 core round shape black Colour PVC Coated aluminium conductor of length 2 (two) feet approx as a sample used for by-passing the energy meter used to run the domestic electrical appliances unauthorisedly as a sample and one yellow card vide SI No: 222940 in the name of Sri Satish Chandra Nayak were seized under cover of warrant issued in presence of Sri Satish Nayak S/O- Sri Satish Chandra Nayak representative of the consumer and witnesses and their signed by them. Thereafter the seized articles were packed and labeled as the properties are in presence of Sri Satish Nayak S/O- Sri Satish Chandra Nayak and witness and signature of witnesses and representative of the consumer attached at the label. After completion of inspection the consumer left the allowed premises at 12:30 PM.

That Sri Satish Chandra Nayak, S/O- Lt Srikanta Nayak of Vill: & P.O- Paniparui, P.S-Egra, Dist-Purba Medinipur has committed an offence u/s 135 (a) of the Electricity Act 2003 read with Amendment Act 2007.

So you are requested to take cognizance of this complaint treating it as FIR.
