2. That your petitioner is being departed by her husband. She got one son and one daughter. She brought up them working as maidservant. She gave her daughter into marriage 16 years back. The daughter his living happily in her in-law house with her children and husband.

3. That your petitioner gave marriage to her son 6 years back with Hiranmoyee. They are the accused person of the instant case. They have a 3 years old male child.
4. That apart from brought up the above said son and daughter your complainant purchased 5.000 decimal Jal land at plot no. 223 of mouza Pitambarchak under Police Station Haldia with her income working as maidservant. Subsequently she developed that Jal land and has constructed there single storied pucca house consisting of one room, latrine, bathroom and 2 nos. Veranda. Your petitioner used to reside there. The accused persons also reside there.
5. That quite some time from the past the accused no. 1 Hiranmoyee Das is in the habit of using filthy language towards your complainant. She often instigated your complainant to commit suicide. The son of your complainant preferred to keep himself silence over such mental torture upon your complainant. Sometimes he also used filthy language towards your complainant in order to support his wife. They are asking your complainant to go away elsewhere leaving your complainant's own house. From the activity of the accused person it is transparent that their intention is to enjoy the property by driving out your complainant from the same of which your complainant is the absolute owner.
6. That on 31.12.2016 at about 10 p.m. while your complainant was taking rest upon returning from her work the accused no. 1 used filthy language towards your complainant. She told that your complainant cannot stay at that room. At the best she can stay in the stair room. Saving the same she pushed out your

complainant from that room. As a result your complainant fell on the floor and got injury on her person. Accused no 2 also attack your complainant with filthy language in support of his wife.

7. That since then your complainant is residing in the open stair room. Your complainant cannot sleep peacefully there since the accused persons threatened your complainant to kill her. Your complainant is suffering from insecurity of her life.

8. That since the Haldia Police Station did not receive written complaint of your petitioner, your petitioner sent the same to the Inspector-in-Charge Haldia Police Station on 05.01.2017 through registered post. But since Haldia Police Station didn't take any action thereafter on 31.01.2017 your complainant sent her complaint to the Superintendent of Police, Purba Medinipur through registered post. But till date Police has not taken any action.

9. That in the mean time on 2nd March 2017 upon returning her house in the night at about 9 pm your petitioner found that the accused person has taken away approx. Rs. 200/- of your petitioner which was kept in a small container at the stair room.

10. That from the above facts it appears that the accused person has committed offence under section 323/506/379/34 of Indian Penal Code. There is sufficient evidence in support of offence committed by the accused person which will be disclosed during the investigation.

11. That in the emergency situation it is highly require to direct the Inspector-in-Charge of Haldia Police Station Under Section 156(3) of Criminal Procedure Code to investigate the matter.

12. That your complainant has approached legal aid authority who has been pleased to appoint advocate Mr. R.K. Das to conduct and file my case.
