Sir,

I, SI Sudipta Chakraborty alongwith C/256 Tulsi Kumar Das, C/1376 Shanti Ghosh and C/1424 Angshuman Bera, all of Haldia PS returned to Haldia P.S and producing herewith the accd. 1. Shiburam Jhulki (23) son of Laxmikanta Jhulki of Chiranjibpur near Yuba Sangha Club Ps Haldia District Purba Medinipur and 2. Rajanikanta Barman (26) son of Late Narayan Barman Ranichak Ps Haldia District Purba Medinipur and also seized articles (1) 01(one) Auto cut Voltage Stabliser, (2) 01 Professional Power Amplifier machine (ALESIS, DOD 430Q) (3) 01 Sound Mixture Pannel Board (ALLEN & HEATH ZED 24) with wire, (4) 02 of loud speakers (JBL SRX 725), (5) About 15 ft electric wire and 03 power cord and submit complaint to the effect that on the night of 26/27-06-17 in course of my night patrolling duty vide Haldia Ps C.C No.1167/17, dt 26.06.17 and Haldia Ps GDE No.863 dt 26.06.17 I had been to Chiranjibpur Nabapally near Electric Sub-Station at about 02.35 hrs on 27.06.17 and found that some persons using loud speakers in a very high amplitude. Seeing Police Party the said persons fled away but we managed to apprehend the above noted accused persons. I waited for some time but none came forward to produce permission copy of microphone/loudspeaker of concerned authority. The said accused persons violated the order of Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta by using loud speakers by not taking permission from the concerned authority. I would like to note that Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta passed order vide Cr. No. 4303(W) of 1995 prohibiting indiscriminate use of microphone and other sound amplifying system and deals with timings of use of such equipments and prescribes the permissible noise levels terms of decibels.

I seized the following articles on the spot in presence of above noted accused persons under proper seizure list.

Description of the seized items:- (1) 01(one) Auto cut Voltage Stabliser, (2) 01 Professional Power Amplifier machine (ALESIS, DOD 430Q) (3) 01 Sound Mixture Pannel Board (ALLEN & HEATH ZED 24) with wire, (4) 02 of loud speakers (JBL SRX 725), (5) About 15 ft electric wire and 03 power cord. As there were no public witnesses, I took signature of C/256 Tulsi Kumar Das, C/1376 Shanti Ghosh and C/1424 Angshuman Bera, all of Haldia PS in seizure list as witness.

Later on during enquiry it was learnt that 1. Shiburam Jhulki (23) Laxmikanta Jhulki of Chiranjibpur near Yuba Sangha Club Ps Haldia District Purba Medinipur and 2. Rajanikanta Barman (26) son of Late Narayan Barman Ranichak Ps Haldia District Purba Medinipur engaged some persons to use those loud speakers in lieu of money.

Hence I pray that a specific should be started against 1. Shiburam Jhulki (23) son of Laxmikanta Jhulki of Chiranjibpur near Yuba Sangha Club Ps Haldia District Purba Medinipur and 2. Rajanikanta Barman (26) son of Late Narayan Barman Ranichak Ps Haldia District Purba Medinipur and others under proper section of law.
