In producing herewith arrested three accused persons namely i) Sukumar Singh (40 yrs) S/o Lt. Felu Singh , ii) Mangal Mal ( 40 yrs) S/o Lt. Nepal Mal and iii) Biswanath Paramanik (27 yrs) S/o Lt. Sisir Pramanik all of village Kumarhat, P.S- Kolaghat, Dist- Purba Medinipur along with seized articles 150 (one hundred and fifty) liters of I/D Liquor in eight plastic Jaricanes in which seven Jaricanes twenty liters each and one Jaricane ten liters as per seizure list and relevant documents.


I S.I Hara Sundar Mahanty attached with Kolaghat P.S, Dist-Purba Medinipur do hereby lodged a complaint against the above noted three accused persons to the effect that on 16.01.17 at 13.45 hrs myself along with force C/1208 Prankrishna Mondal and C/438 Sarbani Sankar Mahapatra of Kolaghat P.S, vide GDE No.- 728 dt. 16.01.17 left P.S for performing special raid against running illegal business, manufacturing, storing and selling of I/D liquor under Kolaghat PS area. During this duty at about 14.45 hrs myself received information from an unknown caller who stated that some persons are running clandestine business , manufacturing , storing, selling, of I/D liquor in their houses with out taking any valid permission. Accordingly, myself along with force with Govt. vehicles left for Kumarhat village to work out the information. At about 15.05 hrs myself along with officer & force reached at village Kumarhat and identified the houses of above noted persons as per my source, on seeing the police party the above noted persons started escaping from there to avoid in police arrest, on a hot chase myself able to apprehend them respectively. Myself contacted with two passerby namely Utpal Samanta S/o Lt. Ashok Samanta and Jahar Dolai S/o Lt. Bijay Dolai both of Kumarhat, P.S- Kolaghat to help police and they agree to it. Then myself along with force and witness started for holding raid at the house of above noted persons and on thorough search the following I/D liquor have been found in their house i.e : i) তিনটি ২০ লিটারের জারিকেনে রাখা ৬০ লিটার চোলাই মদ যাহা ধৃত মঙ্গল মাল এর কাছ থেকে পাওয়া গেল। ২) তিনটি ২০ লিটারের জারিকেনে রাখা ৬০ লিটার চোলাই মদ যাহা ধৃত সুকুমার সিং এর কাছ থেকে পাওয়া গেল। ৩) একটি ২০ লিটারের জারিকেনে রাখা ২০ লিটার এবং একটি ১০ লিটারের রাখা ১০ লিটার চোলাই মদ যাহা ধৃত বিশুনাথ পরামানিক এর কাছ থেকে পাওয়া গেল। and during raid about 1500 liters fermented wash destroyed on the spot. Myself asked to the apprehended persons to produce any valid license for manufacturing, storing, selling, the above articles but they fails to produce any valid license in support of the above articles/I.D liquor. Accordingly myself arrested them observing all arresting formalities, informed them ground of arrest.. Hence myself prepared a seizure list , seized the all articles in presence of accompanied witnesses duly signed by them. The sized articles were properly label and sample taking from each articles. As the said accused persons are running such type of clandestine business without obeying the provision of the Bengal Excise Act. So they are committed offence U/S 46 (A)(c) Bengal Excise Act of 1909. It is also learnt that the above noted accused persons are manufacturing, storing and selling ID liquor illegally and sell the same to the publics. The seized articles (I/D liquor) is approx value of Rs. 6000/-

Therefore I pray that a suitable case may kindly be initiated against accused persons namely i) Sukumar Singh (40 yrs) S/o Lt. Felu Singh , ii) Mangal Mal ( 40 yrs) S/o Lt. Nepal Mal and iii) Biswanath Pramanik (27 yrs) S/o Lt. Sisir Paramanik all of village Kumarhat, P.S- Kolaghat, Dist- Purba Medinipur under proper section of law.
