Sir,

In producing here with the accused under arrest Dulal Barman (62) S/O Lt Ananta Barman of Kishorchak PS- Kolaghat, District- Purba Medinipur along with following seized articles as per seizure list and relevant documents i.e.

1) 10 liters of I/D Liquor in a plastic Jar Cane.

I ASI Santanu Biswas attached with Kolaghat Police Station District- Purba Medinipur do hereby lodged a complaint against the above noted accused person to the effect that on 08.03.17 myself along with C/283 Goutam Payra, C/57 Soumik Maity and C/226 Shyamal Chakraborty detailed in night mobile duty vide Kolaghat PS GDE No-415/16 dated 08.03.17 and C.C No- 1002/17 dt 08.03.17 with Police jeep bearing no WB 30L/8262. During my mobile duty while I along with force had been to village Kishorchak PS- Kolaghat for mobile duty at about 05.00 hrs and found that the above noted accused person is selling I/D liquor from his tally shaded mud built house. When we came closed to the spot i.e. Kishorchak, we chased him and able to intercept the above noted accused person. On being asked the arrested accused person failed to produce any valid license/documents in favor of such business and possession of I/D liquor. On interrogation the above noted accused person confessed his guilt. As the said accused person such possession having no license of selling ID liquor though he is running such type of clandestine business without obeying the provision of the Bengal Excise Act. He is committed an offence U/S 46(A)(c) B.E Act of 1909 So I arrested him and seized (1) one Jar cane 10 liter (approx) may be I/D liquors from his possession after preparing seizure list with label duly sign by the witnesses and the accused person with (2) one 375 ML bottle such containing I/D liquor collected from that two Jar cane as sample with label.

I there fore pray that a suitable case may be initiated against the above noted accused person under proper section of law.
