One, Sri Buddhadeb Das, son of Late Manmatha
math Das of vill- Bamunia, P.O.-Jukhia Bazar, P.S.-
Bhupatinagar, Dist- Purba Medinipur was found operating
the business of drugs keeping an open shop without
drug licences as required under the ~~law~~ law.
The public in general used to purchase medicines
from the unlicensed shop without knowing the status
of shop, thus are being cheated by the shop. It appears
from the poster pasted on the walls of the shop
Dr. Nirmal Kumar Bera, s/o Late Khagendranath
Bera of Mukutsita, P.S.-Khejuri and such other persons
are practicing in the shop and thus inconvenience
Sri Buddhadeb Das used to procure and sell medi-
cines to public who are unaware of the genuinity
of the shop. Disclosing our identity, Sri Buddhadeb Das
was asked to produce the trade licence, possessional docu-
ments, Purchase records of drugs stocked thereat and
issued sale records of drugs. He failed to produce
the documents/papers on demand

The premises was searched in presence of
two local witnesses, Sri Bhim Charan Bar and Sri
Chandra Sakher Mishra and a huge stock of drug
which include Sch H1 drugs were found.

Statutory sampling, as per provision laid down under Sec. 23 of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 were drawn under Sample Mark - AC/01/MAY-17 and AC/02/MAY-17. for Test & Analysis at State Drugs Control & Research Laboratory, 2, Convent Lane, Kolkata-700015 from the stock found.

The entire quantity of drugs were seized in presence of witnesses as per provision of Section 22 (1) (c) of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 and receipt of the seizure in Form 16 was issued to the person, Sri Buddhadeb Das, from whose custody, the drugs were seized.

Thus, Sri Buddhadeb Das in connivance with person named above have violated Sections 18(a), 18(c) of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, which is a cognizable offence punishable under Section 27 of the said Act.

Considering above, you are requested to take custody of the seized drugs and also to take cognizance of the offender as per the law of land. Please treat this as a F.I.R.
