Sir,

In producing herewith arrested accuse namely Sankar Jana (44Yrs) s/o Lt. Mukunda Mohan Jana @ Mukunda of Narikeldaha P.S. Moyna Dist. Purba Medinipur, (owner of illegal I.D liquor shop cum seller. I ASI Ashim Mukharjee. of Moyna PS do here by lodged complaint against Sankar Jana (44Yrs) s/o Lt. Mukunda Mohan Jana @ Mukunda of Narikeldaha, P.S. Moyna Dist Purba Medinipur, to the effect that on 25.03.17 at 18:20 hrs. SI Joydev Mondal duty officer of Moyna P.S. received secret information that, illegal sale of I.D liquor is going on at Narikeldaha area under Moyna P.S. This has a reference to Moyna P.S. GDE No 1047 dtd.25.03.17.

I have been directed to work out the information and accordingly myself along with C/710 Dipak Ranjan Roy C/ 1440 Ujjal Bodhak all of Moyna P.S who were already detailed for Mobile duty vide Moyna P.S. C.C No. 893/17 dated 25.03.17 left for to work out the information.

On 25.03.17 at 19:05 hrs, myself accompanied with force reached at Narikeldaha and identified the house cum liquor shop and held raid at the liquor shop of Sankar Jana. Seeing police some persons who were seating and consuming I.D liquor (cholai) started to flee away but shop owner was apprehended, It revealed that the accused Sankar Jana is selling unauthorized liquor (Cholai) to consumer violating the law of the land relating to such stock and sale governed in the Bengal Excise Act.

On 25.03.17 in between 19:15 hrs, to 19:35 hrs. searched the shop and found approx 10 (Ten) liters I.D. liquor (cholai) in a plastic jerkin valued Rupees 70/- (Seventy) per liter approx.(Total valued Rs 70 X 10 =Rs.700/- approx), which I seized duly signed by the seller and Police witnesses, as no local public person turned up on request. Sample was taken on the spot duly sealed and labeled by me.

In spite of my several request the said shop keeper Sankar Jana could not be able to produce the license or any valid document for selling those liquor and confessed that he actually stocked ID liquor (Cholai) at his house cum I.D Liquor shop under Mouza Narikeldaha PS Moyna and selling illegally. Sankar Jana continuing this illegal business since long causing loss of Govt. revenue. Hence was taken into custody after issuing memo of arrest duly signed by him, as he violated the provision of sec 18 (I) of Bengal Excise Act and he committed an offence u/s 46 A (C) of Bengal Excise Act, 1909.

Under the above circumstances I request you to start a specific case against Sankar Jana (44Yrs) s/o Lt. Mukunda Mohan Jana @ Mukunda of Narikeldaha, P.S. Moyna, Dist. Purba Medinipur (owner of the I.D liquor shop cum seller) and arrange for its investigation.
