Sir,

In producing herewith arrested accuse namely Nakul Khatua (59Yrs) s/o Lt. Gobordhan Khatua of Raychak P.S. Moyna Dist. Purba Medinipur, (owner of illegal I.D liquor shop cum seller) I ASI Ashim Mukharjee. of Moyna PS do here by lodged complaint against Nakul Khatua (59Yrs) s/o Lt. Gobordhan Khatua of Raychak, P.S. Moyna Dist Purba Medinipur, to the effect that on 28.03.17 at 18:25 hrs. SI Paresch Ch. Samanta duty officer of Moyna P.S. received secret information that, illegal sale of I.D liquor is going on at Raychak area under Moyna P.S. This has a reference to Moyna P.S. GDE No 1172 dtd.28.03.17.

I have been directed to work out the information and accordingly myself along with C/538 Anup Bag C/ 710 Dipak Ranjan Roy both of Moyna P.S who were already detailed for evening Mobile duty vide Moyna P.S. C.C No. 917/17 dated 28.03.17 left for to work out the information.

On 28.03.17 at 19:05 hrs, myself accompanied with force reached at Raychak and identified the house cum liquor shop and held raid at the liquor shop of Nakul Khatua. Seeing police some persons who were seating and consuming I.D liquor (chulai) started to flee away but shop owner was apprehended, It revealed that the accused Nakul Khatua is selling unauthorized liquor (Cholai) to consumer violating the law of the land relating to such stock and sale governed in the Bengal Excise Act.

On 28.03.17 in between 19:15 hrs, to 19:45 hrs. searched the shop and found approx 15 (Fifteen) liters I.D. liquor (chulai) in a plastic jerkin valued Rupees 70/- (Seventy) per liter approx. (Total valued Rs 70 X 15 =Rs.1050/- approx), which I seized duly signed by the seller and Police witnesses, as no local public person turned up on request. Sample was taken on the spot duly sealed and labeled by me.

In spite of my several request the said shop keeper Nakul Khatua could not be able to produce the license or any valid document for selling those liquor and confessed that he actually stocked I.D liquor (Cholai) at his house cum I.D Liquor shop under Mouza Raychak PS Moyna and selling illegally. Nakul Khatua continuing this illegal business since long causing loss of Govt. revenue. Hence was taken into custody after issuing memo of arrest duly signed by him, as he violated the provision of sec 18 (I) of Bengal Excise Act and he committed an offence u/s 46 A (C) of Bengal Excise Act, 1909.

Under the above circumstances I request you to start a specific case against Nakul Khatua(59Yrs) s/o Lt. Gobordhan Khatua of Raychak, P.S. Moyna, Dist. Purba Medinipur (owner of the I.D liquor shop cum seller) and arrange for its investigation.
