Sir,

In producing herewith arrested accuse namely 1) Arabinda Barman (21 Yrs) s/o Mrigen Barman of Ismalichak, 2) Sunil Mondal (36) s/o Subal Ch. Mondal of Roychak both of P.S. Moyna, Dist. Purba Medinipur, (owner of illegal I.D liquor shop cum seller), I, ASI. Ashim Mukharjee of Moyna P.S. do here by lodged complaint against Arabinda Barman (21 Yrs) s/o Mrigen Barman of Ismalichak, P.S. Moyna Dist Purba Medinipur, to the effect that on 03.01.17 at 16:30 hrs. ASI Ajoy Mridha duty officer of Moyna P.S. received secret information that, illegal sale of I.D. liquor is going on at Ismalichak GP area under Moyna P.S. This has a reference to Moyna P.S. GDE No 98 dtd. 03.01.17.

I have been directed to work out the information and accordingly myself along with C/ 554 Siddhartha Chakroborty C/ 1247 Sukanta Barman both of Moyna P.S who were already detailed for evening mobile duty vide Moyna P.S.C.C No.17/17 dated 03.01.17 left for to work out the information.

On 03.01.17 at 17:15 hrs. myself accompanied with force reached at Roychak and identified the Id. liquor shop and held raid at the liquor shop of Sunil Mondal. Seeing police some persons who were seating and consuming I.D liquor (cholai) started to flee away but shop owner was apprehended, It revealed that the accused Sunil Mondal is selling unauthorized liquor (Cholai) to consumer violating the law of the land relating to such stock and sale governed in the Bengal Excise Act.

On 03.01.17 in between 17:20 hrs. to 17:45 hrs. searched the shop of Sunil Mondal and found approx 10 (ten) liters I.D. liquor (cholai) in a plastic jerkin valued rupees 70/- (seventy) per liter approx. (Total valued Rs 70X10 =Rs.700/- approx).

And also reached at Ismalichak about 18:05 and search the Id. Liquor shop cum house of Arabinda Barman of Ismalichak in between 18:10 hrs to 18:35 hrs and seized approx 08 Ltrs, Id liquor in a plastic jarican. (Total valued Rs 70X08 =Rs.560/- approx), which I seized duly signed by the sellers and Police witnesses, as no local public person turned up on request. Sample was taken on the spot duly sealed and labeled by me.

In spite of my several request the said shop keeper 1) Arabinda Barman & 2) Sunil Mondal, could not be able to produce the license or any valid document for selling those liquor and confessed that they actually stocked ID liquor (Cholai) at his I.D Liquor house cum shop under Mouza Ismalichak & Roychak P.S Moyna and selling illegally. Arabinda Barman and Sunil Mondal continuing this illegal business since long causing loss of Govt. revenue. Hence they were taken into custody after issuing memo of arrest duly signed by them, as they violated the provision of sec 18 (I) of Bengal Excise Act and he committed an offence u/s 46 A (C) of Bengal Excise Act, 1909.


