Sir,

In producing herewith arrested accuse namely Subrata Sahoo @ Gunda (32 yrs.) s/o Lt Panchanan Sahoo of Hazarichak, PS Moyna, Dist Purba Medinipur, (owner of illegal I.D liquor shop cum seller). I, SI Joydev Mondal of Moyna PS do here by lodged complaint against Subrata Sahoo @ Gunda(32 yrs) s/o Lt Panchanan Sahoo of Hazarichak, PS Moyna, Dist. Purba Medinipur, to the effect that on 17.05.17 at 17:55 hrs. ASI Ashim Mukharjee of Moyna PS received secret information that illegal sale of I.D. liquor is going on at Hazarichak, PS Moyna. This has a reference to Moyna P.S. GDE No 629 dtd. 17.05.17

I have been directed to work out the information and accordingly myself along with C/ 710 Dipak ranjan Roy, C/1440 Ujjal Kanti Bodak both of Moyna PS who were already detailed for evening mobile duty vide Moyna P.S C.C No 1377/17 dtd.17.05.17 left for to work out the information.

On 17.05.17 at 18:45 hrs. myself accompanied with force reached at Hazarichak and identified the liquor shop cum house and held raid at the liquor shop of Subrata Sahoo. Seeing police some persons who were seating and consuming I.D liquor started to flee away but shop owner was apprehended, It revealed that the accused Subrata Sahoo @ Gunda is selling unauthorized liquor to consumer violating the law of the land relating to such stock and sale governed in the Bengal Excise Act.

On 17.05.17 in between 18:50 hrs, to 19:25 hrs. searched the shop and found approx 10 (Ten) liters I.D. liquor (cholai) in a plastic jerkin valued Rupees 70/- (Seventy) per liter approx.(Total valued Rs 70 X 10 =Rs.700/- approx), which I seized duly signed by the seller and Police witnesses, Sample was taken on the spot duly sealed and labeled by me.

In spite of my several request the said shop keeper Subrata Sahoo @ Gunda could not be able to produce the license or any valid document for selling those liquor and confessed that he actually stocked ID liquor at his house cum shop situated under Mouza Hazarichak and selling illegally.

On enquiry it came to learnt that Subrata Sahoo @ Gunda continuing this illegal business since long causing loss of Govt. revenue. Hence was taken into custody after issuing memo of arrest duly signed by him as he violated the provision of sec 18 (1) of Bengal Excise Act and he committed an offence u/s 46 A (C) of Bengal Excise Act,1909.

Under the above circumstances I request you to start a specific case against Subrata Sahoo @ Gunda (32 yrs) s/o Lt Panchanan Sahoo of Hazarichak, PS Moyna, Dist. Purba Medinipur (owner of the I.D liquor shop cum seller) and arrange for its investigation.
