Sir,

In producing herewith arrested accuse namely (i) Milan Samanta (47) s/o Sachin Samanta (ii) Manas Samanta (43) s/o Sasanka Sekhar Samanta both of vill- Ramchak, PS Moyna, Dist Purba Medinipur (owner of illegal I.D liquor shop cum seller), I, ASI Dilip Kr. Jana of Moyna do hereby lodged complaint against (i) Milan Samanta (47) s/o Sachin Samanta (ii) Manas Samanta (43) s/o Sasanka Sekhar Samanta both of Ramchak, P.S. Moyna, Dist. Purba Medinipur, to the effect that on 09.06.17 at 21:05 hrs. ASI Ajoy Mirdha of Moyna P.S. received secret information that illegal sale of I.D liquor is going on at Ramchak, P.S Moyna. This has a reference to Moyna P.S. GDE No 422 dtd. 09.06.17

I have been directed to look out the information and accordingly myself along with C/538 Anup Bag, C/554 Siddhartha Chakraborty both of Moyna PS who were already detailed for evening mobile duty vide Moyna PS C.C No 1595/17 dtd. 09.06.17.

On 09.06.17 at 21:40 hrs. myself accompanied with force reached at Ramchak near Madhyapara Pry. School under Moyna P.S and found (i) Milan Samanta and (ii) Manas Samanta was selling ID Liquor (Challai). Seeing police some persons who were seating and consuming I.D liquor started to flee away but shop owners were apprehended, It revealed that the accused (i) Milan Samanta and (ii) Manas Samanta is selling unauthorized liquor to consumer violating the law of the land relating to such stock and sale governed in the Bengal Excise Act.

On 09.06.17 in between 21:45 hrs. to 22:05 hrs. searched found approx 10 (Ten) liters I.D. liquor (chola) in a plastic jerkin valued Rupees 70/- (Seventy) per liter approx. (Total valued Rs 70 X 10 = Rs.700/- approx), which I seized duly signed by the seller and Police witnesses, as no local public person turned up on request. Sample was taken on the spot duly sealed and labeled by me.

In spite of my several request the said ID Liquor sellers (i) Milan Samanta and (ii) Manas Samanta could not be able to produce the license or any valid document for selling those liquor and confessed that they actually stocked ID liquor and selling illegally at Ramchak near Madhyapara 3 No Pry School.

On enquiry it came to learnt that (i) Milan Samanta and (ii) Manas Samanta continuing this illegal business since long causing loss of Govt. revenue. Hence they were taken into custody after issuing memo of arrest duly signed by them as they violated the provision of sec 18 (i) of Bengal Excise Act and they committed an offence u/s 46 A (C) of Bengal Excise Act, 1909.

Under the above circumstances I request you to start a specific case against (i) Milan Samanta (47) s/o Sachin Samanta (ii) Manas Samanta (43) s/o Sasanka Sekhar Samanta both of vill- Ramchak, PS Moyna, Dist. Purba Medinipur (owners of the I.D liquor seller) and arrange for its investigation.
