Sir,

In producing herewith arrested accuse namely Santosh Maiti (58 Yrs) s/o Lt. Upendranath Maiti of Brindabanchak P.S. Moyna Dist. Purba Medinipur, (owner of illegal I.D liquor shop cum seller. I ASI. Ashim Mukharjee of Moyna P.S. do here by lodged complaint against Santosh Maiti (58 Yrs) s/o Lt. Upendranath Maiti of Brindabanchak, P.S. Moyna Dist Purba Medinipur, to the effect that on 23.02.17 at 06:15 hrs. SI Pranab Samanta duty officer of Moyna P.S. received secret information that, illegal sale of I.D. liquor is going on at Brindabanchak area under Moyna P.S. This has a reference to Moyna P.S. GDE No 890 dtd.23.02.17.

I have been directed to work out the information and accordingly myself along with C/1506 Sumanta Mondal C/206 Brindranath Saha C/758 Tapan Samanta all of Moyna P.S who were already detailed for night patrolling duty vide Moyna P.S. C.C No. 472/17 dated 22.02.17 left for to work out the information.

On 23.02.17 at 06:40 hrs, myself accompanied with force reached at Brindabanchak and identified the house cum liquor shop and held raid at the liquor shop of Santosh Maiti. Seeing police some persons who were seating and consuming I.D liquor (chulai) started to flee away but shop owner was apprehended, It revealed that the accused Santosh Maiti is selling unauthorized liquor (Chulai) to consumer violating the law of the land relating to such stock and sale governed in the Bengal Excise Act.

On 23.02.17 in between 06:45 hrs, to 07:10 hrs. searched the shop and found approx 10 (Ten) liters I.D. liquor (chulai) in a plastic jerkin valued rupees 70/- (seventy) per liter approx.(Total valued Rs 70 X 10 =Rs.700/- approx), which I seized duly signed by the seller and Police witnesses, as no local public person turned up on request. Sample was taken on the spot duly sealed and labeled by me.

In spite of my several request the said shop keeper Santosh Maiti could not be able to produce the license or any valid document for selling those liquor and confessed that he actually stocked ID liquor (Chulai) at his house cum I.D Liquor shop under Mouza Brindabanchak PS Moyna and selling illegally. Santosh Maiti continuing this illegal business since long causing loss of Govt. revenue. Hence was taken into custody after issuing memo of arrest duly signed by him, as he violated the provision of sec 18 (I) of Bengal Excise Act and he committed an offence u/s 46 A (C) of Bengal Excise Act, 1909.

Under the above circumstances I request you to start a specific case against Santosh Maiti (58 Yrs) s/o Lt. Upendranath Maiti of Brindabanchak, P.S. Moyna, Dist. Purba Medinipur (owner of the I.D liquor shop cum seller) and arrange for its investigation.
