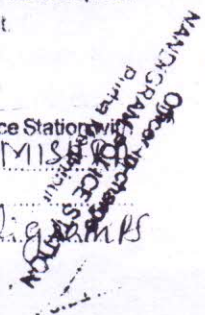

Sir,

In producing herewith one accused persons namely Goutam Maity (32) s/o Sontosh Maity of Vill - Subhanichak PS Nandigram Dist - Purba Medinipur under arrest along with following seized articles as per seizure list and relevant documents. I SI Naba Kumar Koley of Nandigram PS Dist. Purba Medinipur do hereby lodged a complaint against the above noted accused person as suomoto to the effect that today (12.05.17) at 20.15 hrs in course of my evening mobile duty received information that one person is selling I.D liquors at Basanti bazar in open place. Then I informed O/C Nandigram PS and as per his order I along with C/1615 Rashbihari Barik, NVF Sk. Abinur Islam & NVF Sk. Selim Ali all of Nandigram PS left for Basanti bazar to work out the information. We reached at Basanti bazar at about 20.45 hrs and found that the above noted accused person was selling I.D liquor on open field at Basanti bazar. Then we came close to the spot and all the customers successfully fled away and we chased them and able to intercept the above noted accused person. The arrested accused person failed to produce any valid license/documents in favor of such business and possession of I.D liquor. On interrogation the above noted accused person confessed his guilt. As the said accused person such possession of I/.D liquor having no license. He is running such type of clandestine business without obeying the provision of the Bengal Excise Act. He is committed an offence U/S 46(A)(c) B.E. Act of 1909. So I arrested him and seized (1)105 pices CAPTAIN country spirit, each 600 ml per bottle (value - 65/- per bottle) total value 6825/- (2) One 20 liters Jar cane containing 15 liters (approx) I.D liquors (value - 1500/- approx) (3) Ruppes 225/- (I.D liquer & others liquer selling money) from his possession after preparing proper seizure list with label duly signed by the witnesses and the accused person. I also taken one 375 ML glass bottle containing such I.D liquor collected from that Jar cane and one bottle CAPTAIN country spirit as sample with label.

I therefore pray that a suitable case may be initiated against the above noted accused person under proper section of law.
