In producing herewith the 03 (Three) arrested accused persons namely 1) Sk Salauddin (27) S/o Sk Sovan of Baichbari, 2) Sk Najrul Islam (32) S/o Sk Abdul Majid of Vill - Sarberia, 3) Sk Tahebul @ Mantu (30) S/O Sk Subed of Hajrakata all of PS - Nandigram Dist - Purba Medinipur under arrest along with following seized articles as per seizure list and relevant documents. I ASI Ashok Dal attached with Nandigram PS Dist. Purba Medinipur do hereby lodged a written complaint against the above noted accused person as suomoto to the effect that today (29.06.17) at 22.45 hrs in course of evening mobile duty received information that some persons are selling I.D liquors at Nandigram Hospital More under Nandigram P.S. Accordingly I informed the officer in charge of Nandigram PS and as per his direction I along with C/718 Shymal Pathak and C/1042 Ajit Deswali both attached with Nandigram PS left for Nandigram Hospital More to work out the information. We reached at Nandigram Hospital More at about 23.15 hrs. and found the above noted accused persons are selling I.D liquor at Nandigram Hospital More. Then we came close to the spot and all the customers successfully fled away and we able to interception the above noted accused persons. The arrested accused person failed to produce any valid license/documents in favour of such business and possession of I.D liquor. On interrogation the above noted accused persons confessed their guilt. As the said accused persons such possession of I/.D liquor having no license. They are running such type of clandestine business without obeying the provision of the Bengal Excise Act. So they committed an offence U/S 46A(c) B.E. Act of 1909. So we arrested them and seized 01(one) 10 Lts. plastic Jar cane containing 08 Litters (Approx) I.D Liquors (value - Rs 700 (Approx) from their possession. After preparing seizure list with label duly signed by the witnesses and the accused persons with (1) one 375 ML glass bottle containing such I.D liquor collected from that Jar cane as sample with label.

The incident has already been communicated with excise department at Nandigram Circle.

I therefore pray that a suitable case may be initiated against the above noted accused persons under proper section of law.
