Sir,

In producing herewith the accused persons namely Nimai Das@Bula (51) S/o Lt. Bhagyadhar Das of Char Kendamari PS Nandigram Dist Purba Medinipur under arrest along with following seized articles as per seizure list and relevant documents. I SI Vivekananda Halder attached with Nandigram PS Dist. Purba Medinipur do hereby lodged a complaint against the above noted accused persons as suomoto to the effect that today (22.01.2017) at 18.25 hrs in course of mobile duty received information that one persons is selling I.D liquors at Char Kendamari Village Near Anath Brick Field. Then I informed the officer in charge of Nandigram PS and as per his instruction I along with C/731 Mahadeb Murmu of 11<sup>th</sup> SAP & C/755 Bablu Bagdi of 6<sup>th</sup> SAP both are deputation at Nandigram PS left for Char Kendamari to work out the information. We reached at Char Kendamari at about 19.05 hrs and found the above noted accused person was selling I.D liquor at one ghumti situated near Anath Brick Field beside road. Then we came close to the spot and all the customers successfully fled away and we chased him and able to interception the above noted accused person. The arrested accused persons failed to produce any valid license/documents in favour of such business and possession of I.D liquor. On interrogation the above noted accused person confessed his guilt. As the said accused person such possession of I.D liquor having no license. He is running such type of clandestine business without obeying the provision of the Bengal Excise Act. So he committed an offence U/S 46A(c) B.E. Act of 1909. So I arrested him and seized 1(one) 05 Lts Jar cane containing 03 Litters (Approx) I.D Liquors (value - Rs. 300/- from his possession. After preparing seizure list with label duly signed by the witnesses and the accused person with (1) one 375 ML bottles containing such I.D liquor collected from that Jar canes as sample with label.

This is to note here that the incident has already been communicated with excise department at Nandigram Circle.

I therefore pray that a suitable case may be initiated against the above noted accused person under proper section of law.
