Sir,

In producing herewith two arrested accused person namely 1) Nimai Das (50), s/o - Lt. Bhagyadhar Das, 2) Bikash Mandal (50), s/o - Lt. Shyam Mandal both of Char-Kendamari, PS - Nandigram, Dist - Purba Medinipur under arrest along with following seized articles as per seizure list and relevant documents. I ASI Amitava Mukherjee attached with Nandigram PS, Dist. - Purba Medinipur do hereby lodged a complaint against the above noted accused persons as suomoto to the effect that today (11.02.2017) at about 20:15 hrs in course of my mobile duty received information that two persons are selling I.D liquors at Chra-Kendamari near Ferry Ghat. Then I informed O/C Nandigram PS and as per his order I along with force left for Char-Kendamari Ferry Ghat to work out the information. We reached at Char-Kendamari at about 20:45 hrs and found the above noted accused persons are selling I.D liquor in a shop of Bikash Mandal at Chra-Kendamari near Ferry Ghat. Then we came close to the spot and all the customers successfully fled away and we chased them and able to intercept the above noted accused persons. The arrested accused persons failed to produce any valid license/documents in favor of such business and possession of I.D liquor. On interrogation he confessed their guilt. As the said accused persons such possession of I/D liquor having no license. They are running such type of clandestine business without obeying the provision of the Bengal Excise Act. They are committed an offence U/S 46 A(c) of B.E. Act of 1909. So I arrested them and seized (1) one 10 liters Jar cane containing 08 liters (approx) I.D liquors (value - Rs. 800/- approx) from their possession after preparing seizure list with label duly signed by the witnesses and the accused persons with (2) one 375 ML glass bottle containing such I.D liquor collected from that Jar cane as sample with label.

I therefore pray that a suitable case may be initiated against the above noted accused persons under proper section of law.
