Sir,

In producing herewith one accused Buddhadeb Barui @ Buddha (Age-26), s/o- Haradhan Barui of vill- Madhabpur Paschimpara, PO- Kalyanpur, PS- Nandakumar, Dist.- Purba Medinipur seized articles 1) 600 (six hundred Ltrs. (approximate) of in 3(three) iron made barrels each of 200 ltrs loaded with petroleum product and 2) One ltr. Petroleum product taken from the three barrels in duplicate marked A-1, A-2, B-1, B-2, C-1, C-2 in separate plastic bottles as sample for lab testing purpose. I Inspector Sk Jamal Hossain of DEB, Purba Medinipur do hereby lodged a complaint against the above noted accused person to the effect that today (on 19.05.17) at about 12.25 hrs received a secret source information that one illegal business in respect of petroleum product is running at Madhabpur beside NH-41 road under Nandakumar PS. After receiving information informed superiors and left with officeres and force with Govt Vehicle WB 24Y-7001 alongwith laptop, pendrive and computer accessories vide this office MCC no. 10/DEB dt. 19.05.17 for Nandakumar PS areas. ASI Tapas Paul, WC 291 Rabindranath Bari, DyGC D-pankaj Nangi all of DEB, Purba Medinipur and ASI, Tapas Patra, C/ 527, Raghunath Mondal, C/ 190, Krisan Khatun of Nandakumar PS accompanied me and we left PS to work out the source information noting in G.D vide Nandakumar PS GDE No.862 dt.19.05.17. At about 18.45 hrs we reached at Madhabpur beside the NH-41 road in front of Hotel Hindusthan under Nandakumar PS and detected a person as indicated by source who was selling petroleum products. We surrounded the suspect in presence of witnesses giving our identity and on being asked, he disclosed his above name and address. He was then asked to produce valid papers/license from the competent authority in support of such selling/running business but he failed to produce the same. Accordingly, in presence of police personnel and witnesses namely 1) Chandan Bhunia, s/o - Lt. Kesab Bhunia, of vill- Kakurda, PO- Kakurda, PS- Matiyadal 710001 Manna, s/o- Lt. Bamacharan Manna of vill- Mahammadpur, PO & PS- Nandakumar, Dist- Purba Medinipur, the above mentioned articles were seized in between 19.07 hrs. 19.25 hrs. at the PO duly labeled and sealed under proper seizure list duly signed by the witnesses and attested by the said accused person. During interrogation, the accused Buddhadeb Barui confessed that he was selling petroleum products illegally without any license/valid documents, as such I arrested accused Buddhadeb Barui (Age-26), s/o- Haradhan Barui of vill- Madhabpur, PO- Kalyanpur, PS- Nandakumar, Dist.- Purba Medinipur as he violated section 3(d) of Essential Commodities Act X/55 and he is liable for prosecution under section 7(i) a(ii) of Essential Commodities Act X/55. The accused has been informed the ground of arrest.

Therefore, I request you to start a case under section 7(i)(ii) of Essential Commodities Act X/55 against the above accused person Buddhadeb Barui for running an illegal business in a clandestine manner and to keep the seized articles at Nandakumar PS Main/Gen Office for safe keeping.

As per order of superior, the investigation of the case will be taken up by SI Chandan Banerjee of DEB, Purba Medinipur.
