In producing herewith the two arrested accused persons namely 1) Raju Das (30) S/O- Nageswar Das and 2) Nograj Rao (20) S/O- Kanto Rao both of Vill- Purbagorh, PS- Korai, Dist- Jajpur, State- Orissa along with seized articles (i) 17 numbers of Indian Currency notes of Rs 100/- said to be forged bearing serial number 6EQ 670376, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670380, 6EQ 670381, 6EQ 670381 from the exclusive possession of accused Raju Das (30) S/O- Nageswar Das (Marked as Exhibit "A") (ii) 13 numbers of Indian Currency notes of Rs 100/- said to be forged bearing serial number 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382 from the exclusive possession of accused Nograj Rao (20) S/O- Kanto Rao (Marked as Exhibit "B") (iii) Two brown coloured envelope (Marked as Exhibit "C") (iv) One TVS APACHE RTR 180 CC Motor Cycle without any number plate vide Engine No. 0E6CG2086838 and Chassis No. MD634KE66G2C17265 (v) One red-black mobile phone of Lava brand with IMEI No. 1:911457409227782 and 2:911457409752789 having two SIM Card vide No. 9090462290 and 8345064628 from the possession of Nograj Rao (vi) One black coloured mobile phone with IMEI No. 869102020975763 and 869102020975771 having no SIM Card from the possession of Raju Das as per original seizure list, I, SI Vivekananda Halder of Nandakumar PS do hereby lodge this complaint against the above noted accused persons to the effect that today on 21.06.17 at 16:05 hrs, I, SI Vivekananda Halder of Nandakumar PS received a secret telephonic information from reliable source that two persons namely 1) Raju Das (30) S/O- Nageswar Das and 2) Nograj Rao (20) S/O- Kanto Rao both of Vill- Purbagorh, PS- Korai, Dist- Jajpur, State- Orissa will come at Haldia Bus Stand at Sridharpur Morh under Nandakumar PS to make over forged Indian Currency notes to some agents. Accordingly I diarized the matter vide Nandakumar PS G.D.E No. 942 Dtd. 21.06.17 and informed to O/C Nandakumar PS and as per order of O/C Nandakumar PS I along with C/ 1295 Kazi Sahidul Islam, C/190 Kishan Kisku, L/C 1823 Sampa Kundu left for Sridharpur Morh to work out the information vide Nandakumar PS C.C No. 1426 dated 21.06.17 and at 16:25 hrs reached at Haldia Bus Stand at Sridharpur Morh under Nandakumar PS and requisitioned two local persons namely i) Debabrata Pradhan S/O- Jagadish Pradhan of Vill- Mahammadpur (ii) Dipak Mandal S/O- Shyamapada Mandal of Vill- Dhanyaghar both of PS- Nandakumar Dist- Purba Medinipur accompanying us as witness if required at the time of search and seizure after stating them about the information to be worked out and they agreed to accompany us and met with my source and took safe position. At 17:35 hrs we noticed that two persons came at Haldia Bus Stand at Sridharpur Morh under PS Nandakumar with one TVS APACHE RTR 180 CC Motor Cycle without any number plate and as identified by the source immediately we came out from ambush and

encircled the said two persons. On interrogation they both stated their names and addresses as 1) Raju Das (30) S/O- Nageswar Das and 2) Nograj Rao (20) S/O- Kanto Rao both of Vill- Purbagorh, PS- Korai, Dist- Jajpur, State- Orissa. I told them that we have the information that they are carrying forged Indian Currency notes and possessing the same illegally and came here to hand over those forged currency notes to other agents through whom forged notes will be circulated in market as genuine. I have also told them that their persons are required to be searched. I also offered them to search ourselves as right to search and issued notices upon them and was received by them. Accordingly they searched us one by one and all the witnesses first and found nothing except govt. arms and ammunitions and personal belongings. Then I prepared a Nil search list which has been signed by the witnesses and above noted persons with date. There after maintaining all formalities I searched 1) Raju Das (30) S/O- Nageswar Das and recovered one brown coloured envelope from the left side pocket of his wearing pant. Unfolding the envelope 17 numbers of Indian Currency notes of Rs 100/- said to be forged bearing serial number 6EQ 670376, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670380, 6EQ 670381, 6EQ 670381 were found in that envelope. I also searched another person Nograj Rao (20) S/O- Kanto Rao in presence of two local witnesses and recovered one brown coloured envelope from the left side pocket of his wearing pant. Unfolding the envelope 13 numbers of Indian Currency notes of Rs 100/- said to be forged bearing serial number 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382 were found in that envelope. On interrogation they confessed that they used to deal with forged Indian Currency notes and they would supply to one agent for circulation in the open market as genuine. It is their conspiracy to disturb present economic system. They obtained the said forged currency notes from one another agent but they could not tell details about those agents. On being asked they also failed to give any satisfactory answer in support of possession of such forged notes. One black coloured mobile phone with IMEI No. 869102020975763 and 869102020975771 having no SIM Card has been found in right pocket of the wearing pant of accused Raju Das. One red-black mobile phone of Lava brand with IMEI No. 1:911457409227782 and 2:911457409752789 having two SIM Card vide No. 9090462290 and 8345064628 has been found in right pocket of the wearing pant of accused Nograj Rao. Side by side One TVS APACHE RTR 180 CC Motor Cycle without any number plate vide Engine No. 0E6CG2086838 and Chassis No. MD634KE66G2C17265 has been recovered from both of their possession. As they are liable U/S 489B/489C/120B IPC, I arrested the accused 1) Raju Das (30) S/O- Nageswar Das and 2) Nograj Rao (20) S/O- Kanto Rao both of Vill- Purbagorh, PS- Korai, Dist- Jajpur, State- Orissa at 18.35 hrs on 21.06.17 maintaining all norms and seized the following articles preparing proper seizure list duly signed by accused persons and witnesses and labeled them.

Details of articles seized:-

i) 17 numbers of Indian Currency notes of Rs 100/- said to be forged bearing serial number 6EQ 670376, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670379, 6EQ 670380, 6EQ 670381, 6EQ 670381 from the left pocket of the wearing pant of the accused Raju Das (30) S/O- Nageswar Das (Marked as Exhibit "A") ii) 13 numbers of Indian Currency notes of Rs 100/- said to be forged bearing serial number 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382, 6EQ 670382 from the left pocket of the wearing pant of of accused Nograj Rao (Marked as Exhibit "B") iii) Two brown coloured envelopes (Marked as Exhibit "C") iv) One TVS APACHE RTR 180 CC Motor Cycle without any number plate vide Engine No. OE6CG2086838 and Chassis No. MD634KE66G2C17265 from the possession both of them (v) One black coloured mobile phone with IMEI No. 869102020975763 and 869102020975771 having no SIM Card has been seized from right pocket of the wearing pant of accused Raju Das (vi) One red-black mobile phone of Lava brand with IMEI No. 1:911457409227782 and 2:911457409752789 having two SIM Card vide No. 9090462290 and 8345064628 has been seized from right pocket of the wearing pant of accused Nograj Rao. Then I left for PS with seized articles and arrested persons.

Therefore I pray that a case may kindly be started u/s 489B/489C/120B IPC against arrested accused persons 1) Raju Das (30) S/O- Nageswar Das and 2) Nograj Rao (20) S/O- Kanto Rao both of Vill- Purbagorh, PS- Korai, Dist- Jajpur, State- Orissa and arrange for its investigation.
