FOR LOGGING FIR : SNATCHING OF MOBILE PHONE(SAMSUNG GRAND-2)

Respected Sir,

1. With due respect I wish to lodge down the following facts for your kind and favourable action please.
2. I, the above named Ex-JCO went to SBI ATM at Khanchi and operating the same keeping my subject mobile at shelf of the booth at around 1615 to 1630hrs on 06 March 2017. Suddenly three boys entered into the ATM booth, stole my mobile, I was shouting towards the boys for my mobile, but they run away by a Pulsar Bike, (No WB-30P 6586) towards Khanchi/Bagrabaz. The stealing touts demanding Rs. 10,000/-for the stolen mobile through SMS bearing mobile No 7602577730 in favour of bank A/c No 9140100332611-12 in the name of some Sk Ansar Ali, by means of cashless transfer. Again, one of the touts gave me a SBI A/c No 20388028414 of Niraj Kumar, to deposit the amount through SBI Khanchi. But, I ignored to deposit the amount in bank and they compromise the matter to deal hand to hand. On 07 Mar 2017, they call me near Khanchi to return the mobile on exchange of Rs 4000/-. They came at around 1830h, again snatched and cheated away Rs 4000/- but did not hand over the mobile, moreover forcing me to go some unknown place on pillion for returning the mobile. I was unwilling to go with snatchers at unknown place and, unfortunately, came back without mobile. On 08 Mar 2017 again call me at same place near Khanchi to return the mobile on exchange of Rs. 1500/-. They had not come till 1830hrs. and I came back to Thekuabazar. At about 1900hrs, the touts rang up me, tolled to wait near Thekuabazar and promised to return the mobile. They came at around 1930hrs and I gave Rs 500/- honestly, and demanding my mobile. They demanding next Rs. 1000/- which I grabbed in my hand. There was a conflict and battle for mobile and currency Notes. They could not snatch my Rs 1000/- and gone away with same Pulsar bike (No WB-30P 6586) towards Rajarampur. My (Samsung Grand-2) android mobile was very important and cost of Rs 23000/- (bought in March 2011). This mobile set now comprising so many information, important mobile numbers of whole over India during my service. Hence, it is requested to lodge FIR against professional snatchers and to find out the same at the earliest at your end.
3. All the above facts have already been informed and explained before you earlier. Now, I once again requested to lodge the FIR for necessary action at the earliest please.
