Complaint for possession of I/D liquor without any license.

Sir,

In producing herewith one accused person namely Sudip Murmu (35) S/O-Sambhu Murmu of Dehati PS Panskura Dist Purba Medinipur under proper custody arrested in c/w above ref. case I ASI Sudhangshu Samanta beg to state that on 15.05.2017 at 00.05 hrs received a secret source of information that one person namely Sudip Murmu (35) S/O-Sambhu Murmu of Dehati PS Panskura Dist Purba Medinipur was running a business of selling of I/D liquors to different persons from his house cum shop situated at Dehati under Panskura PS. Then I informed O/C Panskura PS and also informed duty officer of Panskura PS and diarized the information by Panskura PS GDE NO-749 Dt. 15.05.17 and to pursue the information I along with force left for village Dehati. I reached at Dehati on 15.05.17 at 00.25 hrs and as a pointed by his source we cordoned the house cum shop of said Sudip Murmu (35) S/O-Sambhu Murmu of Dehati PS Panskura Dist Purba Medinipur, seeing the police force the persons purchasing I/D liquors manage to run away but we manage to apprehend the above person who was selling I/D liquors. We approached local people to witness for search but none came forward for the witness the search and seizure. So in the presence of only police team I searched his shop and below noted quantity of I/D liquors were found from his possession at his house cum shop. On enquiry it was known said Sudip Murmu (35) S/O-Sambhu Murmu of Dehati PS Panskura Dist Purba Medinipur was running the business of selling of I/D liquors since last few days he failed to produce any licence for possession of I/D liquors. So I seized the below noted quantity of I/D liquors from his possession in presence of police witnesses in between 00.40 hrs to 00.50 hrs on 15.05.2017. Description of the seized items:- 1) I/D liquor contained in one 05 (Five) ltr. Plastic jar containing approximately 05 (Five) I/D liquor liters I also took 375 ml of I/D liquor in a bottle as sample, from the above mentioned seized item. Thereafter we return to PS I submit this complaint to start case against him U/S 46 A(c) of B.E Act maintain all norms and condition.
