Sir,

In producing herewith one arrested male accused person namely Madan Paira s/o Lt. Rabindranath Paira of Bulakipur, P.S-Patashpur, Dist. Purba Medinipur, in custody under proper receipt of arrest with seized articles all relevant papers. I beg to submit report that today on 21.02.17 at 21:15 hrs during Evening Mobile duty I ASI Soumen Ratan Pattanayak received information by reliable source that one person namely Madan Paira s/o Lt. Rabindranath Paira of Bulakipur, P.S-Patashpur, Dist. Purba Medinipur, stored huge quantity of HAYWARDS 5000 super strong beer in his house at Bulakipur for selling to local people in lieu of money without any authorization. After receiving the said information I informed to O/C Patashpur PS and as per order by O/C Patashpur PS I along with force rushed to the spot at 21:15 hrs at Bulakipur for holding raid and search out the information at the house of Madan Paira and managed to apprehend a person as advised notified by my source. On being asked the apprehended person disclosed his identity as Madan Paira s/o Lt. Rabindranath Paira of Bulakipur, P.S-Patashpur, Dist. Purba Medinipur. Then I conducted search at his house after observing all formalities in presence of the witnesses. On search I found (Five) Bottles of HAYWARDS 5000 super strong beer (650 ml containing each Rs. 85/- value Rs. 425/-) with in his house. On interrogation Madan Paira disclosed to me that he was selling HAYWARDS 5000 super strong beer for selling to local people illegally. He was a dealer and had any valid papers to support in respect of such businesses and possession of such liquor and spirit, but he unable to produce any valid document on demand or to have any paper for the possession of HAYWARDS 5000 super strong beer. Hence his offence is punishable U/S 46A (c) of the Bengal Excise Act.

Accordingly the HAYWARDS 5000 super strong beer were seized from the house of the accused Madan Paira s/o Lt. Rabindranath Paira of Bulakipur, P.S-Patashpur, Purba Medinipur under proper seizure list duly signed by witnesses and the accused person and I arrested him as his offence is punishable U/S 46 A of Bengal Excise Act 1909. During arrest the accused persons was informed the ground of his arrest and memo of arrest was prepared and provided all sorts of assistance as required.

After such circumstances I do hereby lodged complaint against accused Madan Paira s/o Lt. Rabindranath Paira of Bulakipur, P.S-Patashpur, Purba Medinipur who violated U/S 46 A (c) of Bengal Excise Act, 1909 to initiate a case for investigation.
