Dear Sir,

I do hereby lodge written complaint empowered by the Electricity Act 2003 read with Amendment Act 2007 to the effect that Sri Dilip Jana, S/O - Lt Anil Jana, of Vill-Baruibar, P.O -Palpara, P.S -Patashpur, Dist- Purba Medinipur has committed theft of Electricity u/s 135 of the Electricity Act 2003 read with Amendment Act 2007 as stated hereunder.

On 22.03.2017 at about 02:30 PM I, Sri Aniruddha Hazra, Patashpur CCC along with Sri Manas Maity, A.E.(U), (S&LP), Contai Division Office, Sri Bechan Prasad Barai, Hg. Sr. LM Patashpur CCC and others had been to the village- Baruibar for routine inspection purpose. During inspection it was found that Sri Dilip Jana was consuming electricity dishonestly in his Agricultural premises unauthorisedly by the way of direct hooking from the nearby LT mains (LT bushing of Distribution Transformer) of WBSEDCL, causing considerable loss of revenue of WBSEDCL to the tune of load 6.580 KVA.

As theft of electricity was detected during inspection the illegal hooking line was disconnected & removed from the nearby electrical source and some portion of 3 (three) number separated single core stranded 7/16 swg with one red & other 2 nos yellow coloured PVC coated aluminium conductor of length 2 (two) meter each (approx) along with hooking device as a sample used to run the electrical Pump-motor (STW) set unauthorisedly has been seized under memo of seizure list in the presence of witnesses and their signature is also duly obtained in the seizure list. Sri Nandadulal Jana S/O- Lt Anil Jana acknowledged the same by putting his signature in the Seizure List, Inspection Report. The above seized materials duly packed and labeled at the inspection site and signature of the WBSEDCL representative as well as the representative of the accused has also been obtained on the label. After completion of inspection, the inspection team left the aforesaid premises at about 03:00 PM.

Thus the accused Sri Dilip Jana, S/O - Lt Anil Jana, Vill - Baruibar, P.O -Palpara, P.S -Patashpur, Dist- Purba Medinipur have committed an offence u/s 135 (i) (a) of the Electricity Act 2003 read with Amendment Act 2007.

You are requested to take cognizance of this complain treating it as FIR. The F.I.R is typed by me.
