In producing herewith one arrested male accused person namely Joydeb Samanta(29) s/o Lt. Sukumar Samanta of Village Ramkhali, P.S-Patashpur, Dist. Purba Medinipur, in custody under proper seizure list with seized articles all relevant papers. I beg to submit report that today on 17.04.17 at 11:55 hrs during Special Raid duty I SI Arup Pradhan received information by reliable source that one person namely Joydeb Samanta(29) s/o Lt. Sukumar Samanta of Village Ramkhali, P.S-Patashpur, Dist. Purba Medinipur, stored huge quantity of SUN Country spirit at his Tea Shop at Harimorh under mouza Angachia, PS Patashpur for selling to local people in lieu of money without any authorization. After receiving the said information I informed to O/C Patashpur PS and as per order by O/C Patashpur PS myself along with force rushed to the spot at 18.25 hrs at Harimorh under mouza Angachia for field raid and work out over such information at the Tea Shop of Joydeb Samanta and managed to arrest one person as shown and identified by my source. On being asked the apprehended person about his identity as Joydeb Samanta(29) s/o Lt. Sukumar Samanta of Village Ramkhali, P.S-Patashpur, Dist. Purba Medinipur. Then I conducted search at his tea shop after observing all formalities in the presence of the witnesses. On search I found that 03 (three) bottles of SUN country spirit each containing 600 ml each, Rs 55/- each, total valued Rs 165/- in his Tea Shop. On interrogation Joydeb Samanta disclosed to me that he stored such SUN Country spirit for selling to local people in lieu of money. He was asked whether he had any valid papers to support in respect of such businesses and production of such Country spirit but he unable to produce any valid document on demand or to have any paper for the such of Sun Country spirit. Hence his offence is punishable U/S 46A (c) of the Bengal Excise Act, 1909.

Accordingly the 03(three) bottles of Sun Country spirit were seized from the tea shop of the accused Joydeb Samanta(29) s/o Lt. Sukumar Samanta of Village Ramkhali, P.S-Patashpur, Dist. Purba Medinipur under proper seizure list duly signed by witnesses and the accused person and I arrested him as his offence is punishable u/s 46 (A) c of Bengal Excise Act 1909. During arrest the accused persons was informed about the ground of his arrest and memo of arrest was prepared and provided all sorts of assistance as per law.

Under such circumstances I do hereby lodged complaint against accused Joydeb Samanta(29) s/o Lt. Sukumar Samanta of Village - Ramkhali, P.S-Patashpur, Purba Medinipur who violated U/S 46 A (c) of the Bengal Excise Act, 1909 to initiate a case for investigation.

I beg to submit report that today on 17.04.17 at 18.55 hrs during Special Raid, duty I SI Arup Pradhan received information by reliable source that one person namely Joydeb Samanta(29) s/o Lt. Sukumar Samanta of Village Ramkhali, P.S-Patashpur, Dist. Purba Medinipur, stored huge quantity of SUN Country spirit at his Tea Shop at Harimorh under mouza Angachia, PS Patashpur for selling to local people in lieu of money without any authorization. After receiving the said information I informed to O/C Patashpur PS and as per order by O/C Patashpur PS I myself along with force rushed to the spot at 18.25 hrs at Harimorh under mouza Angachia for holding raid and work out over such information at the Tea Shop of Joydeb Samanta and managed to apprehend a person as shown and identified by my source. On being asked the apprehended person his identity as Joydeb Samanta(29) s/o Lt. Sukumar Samanta of Village Ramkhali, P.S. Patashpur, Dist. Purba Medinipur. Then I conducted search at his tea shop after observing all formalities. In presence of the witnesses, On search I found that 03 (three) bottles of SUN country spirit containing 600 ml each, Rs 55/- each, total valued Rs 165/- in his Tea Shop. On interrogation Joydeb Samanta disclosed to me that he stored such SUN Country spirit for selling to local people. He was asked whether he had any valid papers to support in respect of such businesses and possession of such Country spirit but he unable to produce any valid document on demand or to have licence for the sale of Sun Country spirit. Hence his offence is punishable U/S 46A (c) of the Bengal Excise Act, 1909.

Accordingly the 03(three) bottles of Sun Country spirit were seized from the tea shop of the accused Joydeb Samanta(29) s/o Lt. Sukumar Samanta of Village Ramkhali, P.S-Patashpur, Purba Medinipur under proper seizure list duly signed by witnesses and the accused person and I arrested him as his offence is punishable u/s 46 (A) c of Bengal Excise Act 1909. During arrest the accused persons was informed about the ground of his arrest and memo of arrest was prepared and provided all sorts of assistance as per law.

Under such circumstances I do hereby lodged complaint against accused Joydeb Samanta(29) s/o Lt. Sukumar Samanta of Village - Ramkhali, P.S-Patashpur, Purba Medinipur who violated U/S 46 A (c) of the Bengal Excise Act, 1909 to initiate a case for investigation.
