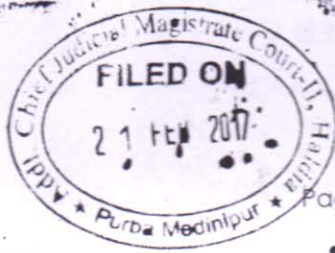

Most Respectfully Shweath:

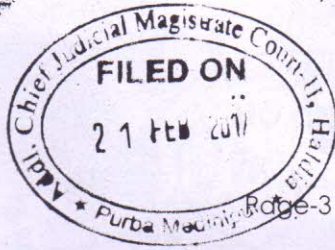
1. That your petitioner is a peace loving and law abiding citizen of this locality.
2. That Accused No. 1 & 2 is parent-in-laws of your Complainant. Accused No. 4 & 3 is the sister of his wife of your Complainant and her husband.

3. That Smt. Sutapa Bera is the legally married wife of your Complainant. She was residing with your Complainant in his residence purchased and made at his expenses in the name of his wife Smt. Sutapa Bera. She left voluntarily in the last part of February'2014 along with their minor son Dwipsankar Bera due to illicit relation with one Ghanashyam Kabir resident of Chaitanyapur under P.S. Sutahata.
4. That subsequently the son of your Complainant came back and was residing with him and his 95 years old aged sick mother and was studying in school. The wife of your Complainant gave two nos. mobile phones to that minor child for his use with ulterior motive.
5. That the wife of your Complainant filed Misc. Case No. 172/2014 against him claiming maintenance. On 16.11.2016 while interim maintenance petition filed by Smt. Sutapa Bera was being heard before the Ld. Judicial Magistrate at Haldia, she claimed maintenance against the above said minor son also. Due to cross claim in respect of custody of minor son, Ld. Judicial Magistrate directed both the party for production of minor son on the next day (17.11.2016).
6. That upon receiving information of that order the Accused persons immediately rushed to the residence of your Complainant on the same day (16.11.2016) at about 2 p.m. Refusing the objection raised by 95 years old sick mother of your Complainant, the Accused person forcefully and illegally entered in to the residence of your Complainant, took away the minor son with them along with his books, copies, pant, shirt etc. There was Rs. 10, 000/- in cash in a bag which your Complainant took from his friend Jiyad Ali as loan for the treatment of his ailing mother. The Accused person took away the same. The Accused person also took

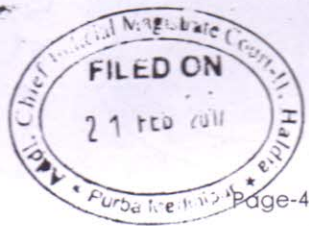

away a golden necklace & a pair of ear ring of his mother of weight approx 15 gm of value more than Rs. 50, 000/- which was also kept in another bag.

7. That upon returning home from the Court your Complainant came to know all this. He brought all the matters to the kind knowledge of Ld. Judicial Magistrate on the next day (17.11.2016). Your Complainant also produced some books and copies, shirt & shoe of his minor son before that Ld. Court which has not taken away by the Accused persons. Upon perusing those articles and also examining the minor son on dock Ld. Court came to the conclusion that the son was residing along with your Complainant and paying occasional visit to his mother.
8. That the above said Accused person in absence of your Complainant refusing the objection raised by his mother forcefully and illegally entered into the residence of your Complainant and dishonestly taken away the above said articles from the possession of your Complainant. It appears that the Accused person has committed offence under Section 448/380/34 of Indian Penal Code.
9. That there are sufficient evidence in support of the offence committed by the Accused persons which will be unearth during investigation.
10. That after such incident your Complainant went to the Sutahata Police Station to lodge written complaint. But after passing considerable time they refused to accept the complaint. Thereafter your Complainant sent the written complaint to the Officer-in-Charge Sutahata Police Station through registered post with A/D on 29.11.2016. But since the local Police Station did not take any action your Complainant thereafter sent written complaint to the Superintendent of Police, Purba Medinipur at Tamluk on

09.12.2016 through registered post with A/D. But till date no action has been taken by the Police.

11. That in the emergency situation it is highly requires to direct the Officer-in-Charge Sutahata Police Station under Section 156(3) of Criminal Procedure Code to investigate the matter for the interest of justice.

In the above context your Complainant prays that the Ld. Court shall be graciously pleased to direct Officer-in-Charge, Sutahata Police Station under Section 156(3) of Criminal Procedure Code to investigate matter and oblige.

And for this act of kindness your Complainant, as in duty bound, shall ever pray.
