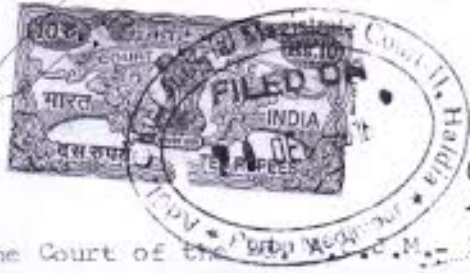

The Complainant begs to submit :

1. That the Complainant is ~~was~~ an widow who has been residing in her own house along with two minor grand sons those who have lost their parent.
2. That accused 1 to 4 are the sons of 1st. wife of your petitioner's husband who are greedy arrogant and dangerous in nature.
3. That the land bearing Plot No.1077 under Mouza-Basancha just by the side of Hadia village belongs to your complainant.
4. That the land had been purchased in the name of your Complainant in the year of ¹⁹⁸² two sale deeds being no.4952 , 660.
5. That the record of rights have been prepared in the name of your complainant and the complainant paid taxes of the land to the Govt.
6. That the accused persons have no right, title and possession over the land.
7. That there ~~was~~ various trees (Description are given below) were standing on that plot which are the main source of income of the unfortunate widow.
8. That after demise of son and daughter in-law of your complainant ~~and your~~ the accused persons tried to evict your complainant and created pressure to leave all property in their names.
9. That on the ~~ax~~ date of occurrence the accused persons cut the trees with the help of accused No.5 and his associates by "saw" and seperat~~e~~ in several item and took away by Machine van and kept it in the sawmill of accused No.5.
10. That the value of the trees are more than ₹.2,00,000/ (Two Lakhs).



11. That after getting information the complainant came to P.O. and protested but in vain. Where as accused No.1 to 4 tried to kill throwing weapon.
12. That several men saw the occurrence and raised protest against the illegal activity of accused persons.
13. That the complainant requested accused no.5 for not cutting and taking away the trees but he did not care to me.
14. That the complainant informed it to Anchal Sedesya who protested but in vain. Previously he directed the accused persons not to cut the trees but the accused did not listen to him.
15. That on 07.12.16 the complainant lodged the complaint but no effect.
16. That on 13.12.16 the complainant informed the matter to S.P. Purba Medinipur, Still now no case is started against the accused.
17. That recovery of the trees are required.
18. That the trees are lying in the saw mill of accused no.5 at Chaitanyapur.
19. That the accused persons committed the offence u/s. 379 I.P.C.

In the premises the Complainant prays before the court to send the same to O/C Sutehata for lodging a case.
