In producing herewith arrested accused person namely Binanda Maity aged 39 yrs s/o Lt. Jagadish Maity of Uttar Narkelda, P.S. Tamluk, Dist- Purba Medinipur along with the seized articles (i) five (05) bottles of country spirit of Sun brand and each bottle containing 600 ml. and cost of Rs. 65/- per bottle under proper seizure list. I ASI Bishnupada Panda of Tamluk P.S. do hereby lodged complaint to the effect that on 23.02.2017 at 12.45 hrs. myself along with C/1650 Abdul Rajjak, C/ 517 Thakurdas Mukharjee left P.S. to perform evening mobile duty vide Tamluk P.S. G.D.E. no. 1266 dated 23.02.2017 and C.C. no 764 dated 23.02.17. In course of evening mobile duty at 20.15 hrs at Nimtouri received information from my reliable source that one person selling country sprit illegally at Nitmtouri from his temporary shop. I contacted with two passersby namely (i) Ashok Bhowmik s/o Himanshu Bhowmik of Uttar Sonamui, PS- Tamluk, Dist- Purba Medinipur and (ii) Sadananda Jana s/o Lt. Nimai Jana of Garkilla, PS- Tamluk, Dist- Purba Medinipur and request them to assist police and they agreed. We held raid at that temporary shop as identified by my source and apprehended the country spirit seller in presence of witnesses as noted above. Search was made at the temporary shop in presence of apprehended person, above noted witnesses and police party and found (i) five (05) bottles of country spirit of Sun brand and each bottle containing 600 ml. and cost of Rs. 65/- per bottle kept in a nylon bag. Being asked the apprehended person disclosed his identity as Binanda Maity aged 39 yrs s/o Lt. Jagadish Maity of Uttar Narkelda, P.S. Tamluk, Dist- Purba Medinipur and on demand he fails to produce any valid license, papers, documents or challan for posses and sells country spirit to publics. I seized (i) five (05) bottles of country spirit of Sun brand and each bottle containing 600 ml. and cost of Rs. 65/- per bottle kept in a nylon bag after preparing proper seizure list duly signed by the above noted witnesses and as well as the apprehended person. I took sample one bottles country spirit from seized article and labeled it also. I arrested the apprehend person Binanda Maity, issued memo of arrest and informed him ground of arrest. During local enquiry it is crystal clear that Binanda Maity illegally posses and sells country spirit to publics.

Hence, I pray a cog case may kindly be started against accused namely Binanda Maity aged 39 yrs s/o Lt. Jagadish Maity of Uttar Narkelda, P.S. Tamluk, Dist- Purba Medinipur under proper section of law.
