
In producing herewith arrested accused person namely Sambhu Singh (Aged about 50 Yrs) S/O Lt. Radhanath Singh of Nilkuntha, P.S - Tamluk, District- Purba Medinipur along with the seized articles (i) five bottles Bindash Premium country spirit of and each bottle containing 600 ml. and cost of Rs. 65/- per bottle under proper seizure list. I ASI Biman Sardar of Tamluk P.S. do hereby lodged complaint to the effect that on 15.05.2017 at 16.35 hrs. myself along with C/1246 Sanjib Das, C/917 Prabir Das left P.S. for holding raid duty at P.S. area vide Tamluk P.S. G.D.E. no. 840 dated 15/05/2017 and C.C. no 1898 dated 15/05/17. In course of raid duty at Radhamoni received information from my reliable source that one person selling country sprit to public illegally at Nilkuntha from his gumti. We reached at Nilkuntha 19.35 hrs. and found Sambhu Singh selling country spirit to public. Held raid at the gumti of Sambhu Singh. Search was made at the gumti in presence of witnesses and police party and seized five bottle Bindash Premium country spirit from the possession of Sambhu Singh. Being asked he disclosed his identity as Sambhu Singh aged 50 yrs s/o Lt. Radhanath Singh of Nilkuntha, P.S. Tamluk, Dist- Purba Medinipur and on demand he fails to produce any valid license, papers, documents or challan for posses and sells country spirit to publics. I seized (i) five bottles of Bindash Premium country spirit and each bottle containing 600 ml. and cost of Rs. 65/- per bottle kept after preparing proper seizure list duly signed by the witnesses. I took sample from seized article and labeled it also. I arrested the apprehend person Sambhu Singh, issued memo of arrest and informed him ground of arrest. During local enquiry it is crystal clear that Sambhu Singh illegally posses and sells country spirit to publics.

Hence, I pray a cog case may kindly be started against accused namely Sambhu Singh aged 50 yrs s/o Lt. Radhanath Singh of Nilkuntha, P.S. Tamluk, Dist- Purba Medinipur under proper section of law.
