Sir,

In producing herewith one arrested accused person namely Nandalal Maity (Ages 50 Yrs) S/O Sachi Maity of Vill-Garkilla, PS-Tamluk, Dist. Purba Medinipur along with seized articles as per seizure list. I have submitted a written complainant against him to the effect that today i.e. 04.02.2017 at 08.15 hrs. myself along with C/517 Thakur Das Mukharjee, NVF Chandra Sekhar Bhowmik, L/C-1822 Sagarika Singha all of Tamluk PS vide Tamluk PS G.D.E. No.-220 dated 04.02.2017 and C.C. No. 424 dated-04.02.2017 were performing morning mobile duty at P.S. area. In course of my mobile duty received information from a reliable source regarding selling of illegal I/D liquor by the above noted accused person at Garkilla village in a temporary shop. I immediately informed the matter to O/C Tamluk PS over telephone, and as per instruction of O/C Tamluk P.S. left for Garkilla to work out the information.

Myself along with force while reached at Garkilla village at 13.10 hrs. and as identified the shop of Nandalal Maity by the source, we stopped the vehicle in front of the shop of Nandalal Maity. But in short time, getting sound of Police Jeep, some unknown person managed to flee away who were probably buying liquor from Nandala Maity. He also tried to flee away. However, we blocked the entrance and giving my identity and stating about the information, we asked some local people to accompany us and they agreed. During search approx 05 (five) Ltrs. I/D liquor loaded in three plastic jaricane and 10 (Ten) bottles Country Sprit has been found from the shop. On being asked they failed to produce any license / Papers / Challan for carrying such quantity of I/D liquor. Then I seized the above mentioned I/D liquor under proper seizure list duly signed by witnesses, I extracted one liter I/D liquor from the above noted seized article as test sample. Then the seized articles were labeled and arrested the above noted accused person after preparing proper memo of Arrest.

I therefore request to kindly start a specific case against accused Nandalal Maity (Ages 50 Yrs) S/O Sachi Maity of Vill-Garkilla, PA-Tamluk, Dist. Purba Medinipur under 46 A© BE Act, 1909 and arranged for its investigation.
