producing herewith arrested accused person namely Chandra Kanta Jana aged 47 s/o Lt. Banamali Jana of Srikantha Kalagonda, P.S. Tamluk, Dist- Purba Medinipur along with the seized articles (i) four liters I.D liquors containing two plastic bottle each bottle two liters & ten bottles of country spirit and each bottle containing 600 ml. and cost of Rs. 65/- per bottle under proper seizure list. I ASI Bishnupada Panda of Tamluk P.S. do hereby lodged complaint to the effect that on 30.03.2017 at 18.10 hrs. myself along with C/750 Jayanta Patra, C/1650 Abdul Rajjak left P.S. to perform special raid duty vide Tamluk P.S. G.D.E. no. 1664 dated 30.03.2017 and C.C. no 1287 dated 30.03.17. In course of special raid duty at Radhamoni received information from my reliable source that one person selling I.D liquor and country spirit illegally at Srikantha Kalagonda open place. We held raid at that place at 19.40 hrs Srikantha Kalagonda as identified by my source and apprehended the I.D liquor and country spirit seller in presence of witnesses. Search was made at the open place in presence of apprehended person, witnesses and police party and found (i) four liters I.D liquors containing two plastic bottle each bottle two liters & ten bottles of country spirit and each bottle containing 600 ml. and cost of Rs. 65/- per bottle kept in a nylon bag. Being asked the apprehended person disclosed his identity as Chandra Kanta Jana aged 47 yrs s/o Lt. Banamali Jana of Srikantha Kalagonda, P.S. Tamluk, Dist- Purba Medinipur and on demand he fails to produce any valid license, papers, documents or challan for posses and sells I.D liquor and country spirit to publics. I seized (i) four liters I.D liquors containing two plastic bottle each bottle two liters & ten bottles of country spirit and each bottle containing 600 ml. and cost of Rs. 65/- per bottle in a nylon bag after preparing proper seizure list duly signed by the witnesses and as well as the apprehended person. I took sample from seized article and labeled it also. I arrested the apprehend person Chandra Kanta Jana issued memo of arrest and informed him ground of arrest. During local enquiry it is crystal clear that Chandra Kanta Jana illegally posses and sells I.D liquor and country spirit to publics.

Hence, I pray a cog case may kindly be started against accused namely Chandra Kanta Jana aged 47 yrs s/o Lt. Banamali Jana of Srikantha Kalagonda, P.S. Tamluk, Dist- Purba Medinipur under proper section of law.
