Sir,

In producing herewith one arrested accused person namely (1) Joydev Paul (38 yrs) S/O Dharpahori Paul of Village Sundarpur PS Talpatighat coastal Dist – Purba Medinipur under arrest along with following seized articles as per seizure list and relevant documents. I ASI Jamsed Ali Saha of Talpatighat coastal PS Dist. Purba Medinipur do hereby lodged a complaint against the above noted accused persons as suomoto to the effect that on 6/02/17 at 14.25 hrs I along with force left PS vide Talpatighat coastal PS GDE No-161 and c.c no- 188 both dt 6/02/17 for performing mobile patrolling duty at ps area. In course of my mobile duty received information that one person is selling I.D liquors at Alipur market under Talpatighat coastal PS at his shop .Then I informed O/C Talpatighat coastal and I along with C/245 Swarup Dowari & C/ 685 Sambhu Singh both of Talpatighat coastal PS to work out the information. We reached at Alipur Market at about 18.25 hrs and found the above noted accused person was selling I.D liquor at Alipur market at his shop. Then we came close to the spot and all the customers successfully fled away and we chased them and able to intercept the above noted accused person. The arrested accused person failed to produce any valid license/documents in favor of such business and possession of I.D liquor. On interrogation the above noted accused person confessed his guilt. As the said accused person such possession of I/D liquor having no license. He is running such type of clandestine business without obeying the provision of the Bengal Excise Act. He is committed an offence U/S 46 A(c) of B.E. Act of 1909. So I arrested him and seized-(1) One piece 5 liters Jar cane containing 04 liters (approx) I.D liquors (value – Rs. 400/- approx) from his possession after preparing seizure list with label duly signed by the witnesses and the accused person with (2) One piece 375 ML glass bottle containing such I.D liquor collected from sl no1 as sample with label.

This is to note here that the incident has already been communicated with O/C excise department at Reapara , under Nandigram PS. .

I therefore pray that a suitable case may be initiated against the above noted accused persons under proper section of law.
