Sir,

In producing herewith two arrested accused persons namely (1) Lakhan Patra (65yrs) s/o Lt Gunadhar Patra (2) Ramhori Patra (75 yrs) s/o Lt Gunadhar Patra both of Village Sahabnagar PS Talpatighat coastal Dist. Purba Medinipur under arrest along with following seized articles as per seizure list and relevant documents. I ASI Haradhan Singha of Talpatighat coastal PS Dist. Purba Medinipur do hereby lodged a complaint against the above noted accused persons as suomoto to the effect that on 25/5/17 at 16.05 hrs I along with force left PS vide Talpatighat coastal PS GDE No-1448 and C.C no- 797 both dt 25/5/17 for performing mobile patrolling duty at PS area. In course of my mobile duty received information that two persons are selling I.D liquors at village Sahabnagar under Talpatighat coastal PS beside "Sahabnagar uttar polly sisu sikha Kendra". Then I informed O/C Talpatighat coastal and I along with C/636 Shyamalendu Pan & C/ 231 Sujit Pundit both of Talpatighat coastal PS to work out the information. We reached at Sahabnagar at about 20.15 hrs and found the above noted accused persons were selling I.D liquor at village Sahabnagar beside "Sahabnagar uttar polly sisu sikha Kendra". Then we came close to the spot and all the customers successfully fled away and we chased them and able to intercept the above noted accused persons. The arrested accused persons failed to produce any valid license/documents in favor of such business and possession of I.D liquor. On interrogation the above noted accused persons confessed their guilt. As the said accused persons such possession of I.D liquor having no license. They are running such type of clandestine business without obeying the provision of the Bengal Excise Act. They are committed an offence U/S 46 A(c) of B.E. Act of 1909. So I arrested them and seized-(1) One piece 20 liters Jar cane containing 18 liters (approx) I.D liquors (value - Rs. 1800/- approx) from their possession after preparing seizure list with label duly signed by the witnesses and the accused person with (2) One piece 375 ML glass bottle containing such I.D liquor collected from each Jar cane as sample with label.

This is to note here that the incident has already been communicated with O/C excise department at Reapara, under Nandigram PS.

I therefore pray that a suitable case may be initiated against the above noted accused persons under proper section of law.
